## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 2 PERCENT

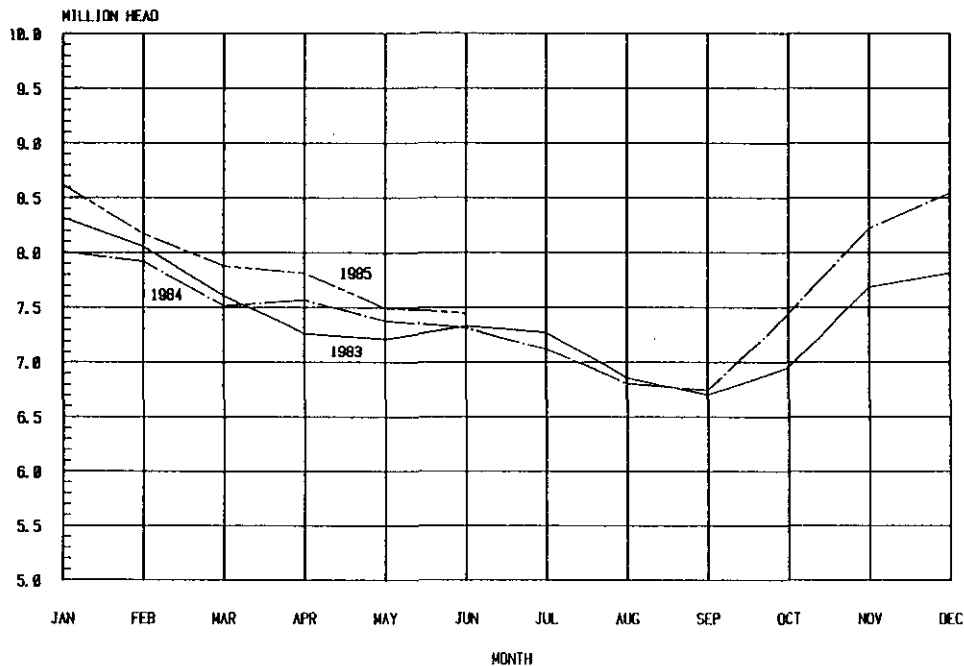
Cattle and calves on feed June 1 for the slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.44 million head, up 2 percent from both June 1, 1984 and 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during May totaled 1.59 million, 3 percent below last year but 1 percent above May two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during May totaled 1.67 million, a 7 percent decrease from last May and 9 percent less than May 1983. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.54 million for May were 3 percent below May 1984 and 9 percent below two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 128 thousand head compared with 219 thousand in May 1984 and 150 thousand during May 1983.
