CATTLE ON FEED DOWN LESS THAN 1 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1985 for slaughter market in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 8.66 million head, down fractionally from July 1 last year and 5 percent less than two years ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. On feed numbers were the lowest for this date since 1981.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.25 million steers and steer calves, down 5 percent from a year ago and 7 percent below 1983. This group represented 61 percent of the total July 1 number on feed compared with 63 percent in 1984. Heifers and heifer calves, at 3.38 million, were the highest since 1978, up 7 percent from last year and virtually the same as 1983.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June quarter totaled 5.19 million, 7 percent below last year, 12 percent below 1983 and lowest for this comparable period since 1975. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 439 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 4.75 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 5.76 million, up 3 percent from the same quarter last year, 4 percent above 1983 and the largest for the quarter since 1978.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER UP 5 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.98 million head during the July-September quarter of 1985. This would be 5 percent greater than the third quarter marketings in 1984, and 1 percent above 1983.

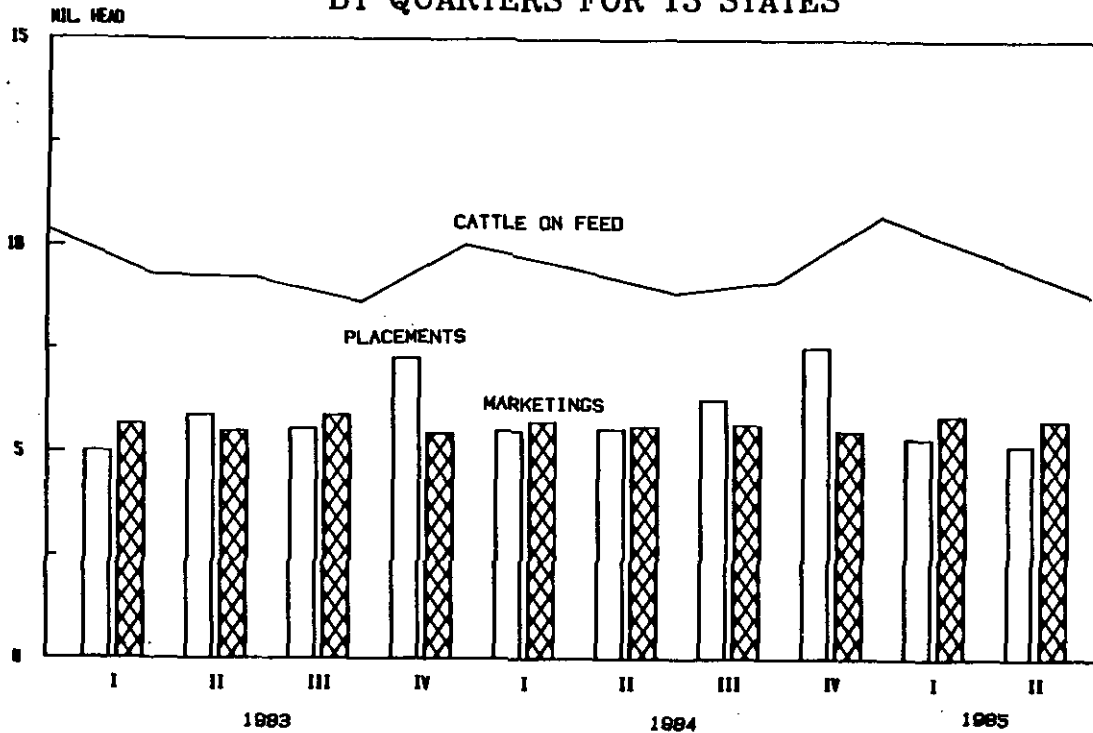
CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 1 PERCENT

Cattle on feed July 1, 1985 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.05 million, 1 percent below the previous year and 3 percent less than 1983. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during June, of 1.27 million, were 12 percent below last year's level and 21 percent below June 1983. MARKETINGS during June totaled 1.57 million, 2 percent above 1984, and virtually the same as 1983. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during June was 87 thousand head, 7 percent below last year but 12 percent above 1983.

The April-June quarterly marketings for the 7 States, at 4.76 million, were up 1 percent from last year and 3 percent above the same quarter in 1983. Marketings for the 7 States during the April-June quarter accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the July-September 1985 quarter are estimated at 5.00 million, up 6 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1984 and 4 percent above 1983.
