CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 6 PERCENT

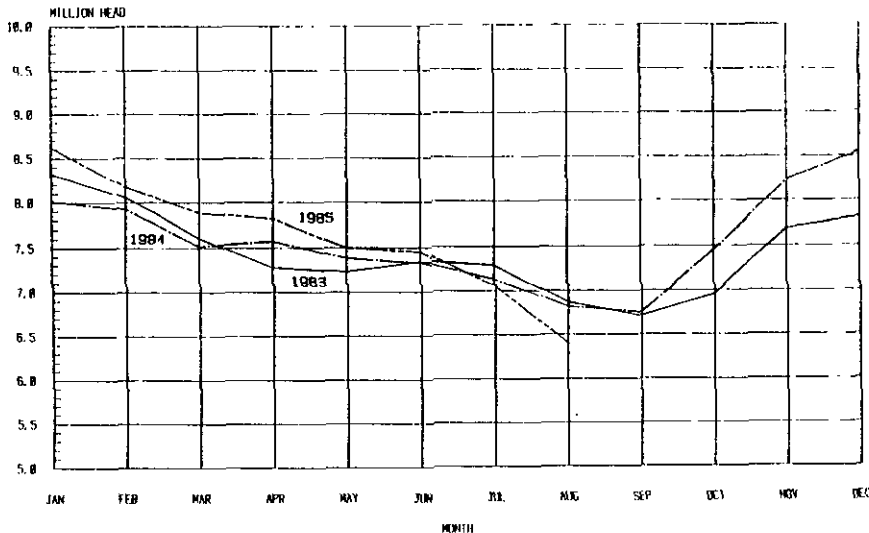
Cattle and calves on feed August 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.39 million head, down 6 percent from a year ago and 7 percent below August 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during July totaled 1.67 million, 8 percent above last year and 12 percent more than July two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during July totaled 1.07 million, down 19 percent from last year and 9 percent below July 1983. Net Placements of 1.01 million for July are 18 percent below last year and down 6 percent from two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 61 thousand head, compared with 84 thousand during July 1984 and 94 thousand during July 1983.
