## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 8 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed November 1 for the slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.56 million head, down 8 percent from a year ago and 2 percent below November 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

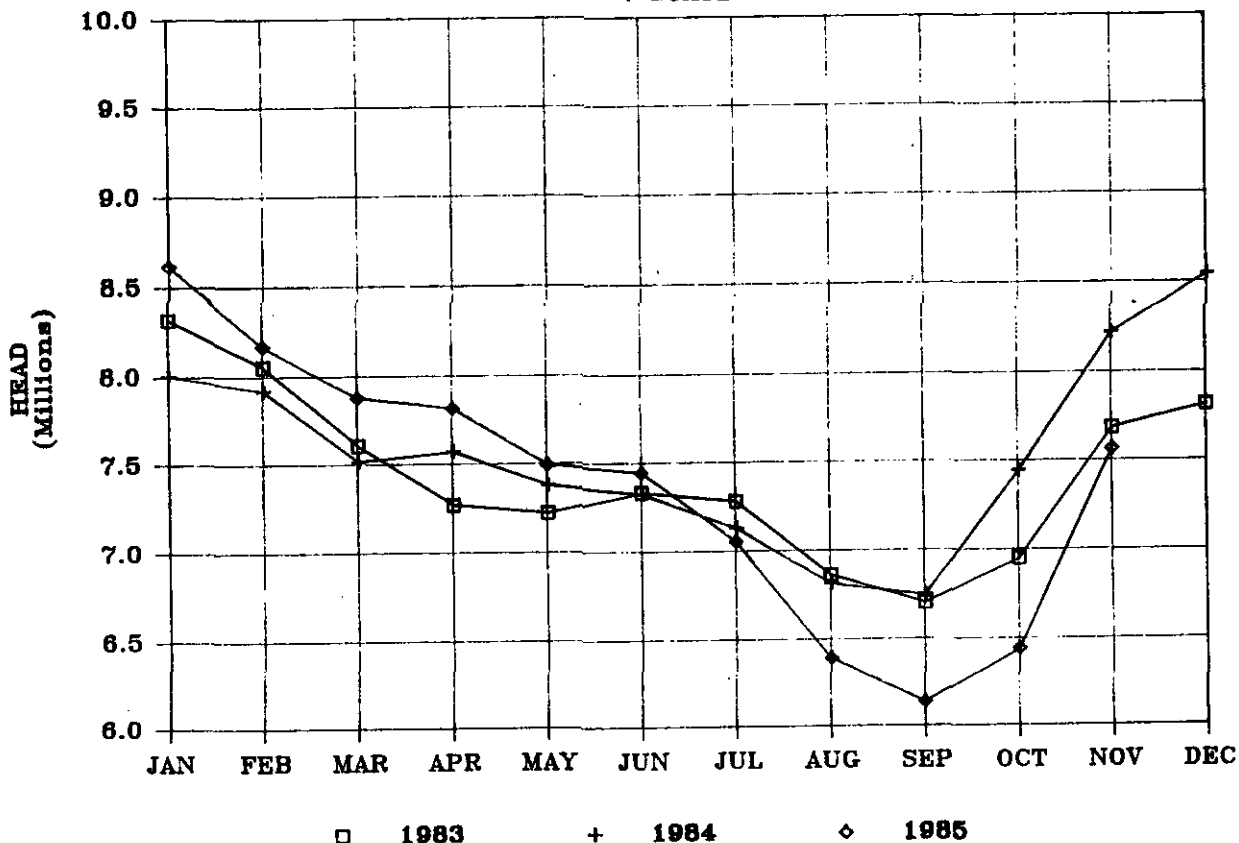
MARKETINGS of fed cattle during October totaled 1.57 million, 5 percent below last year and 3 percent less than October two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October totaled 2.78 million, up 9 percent from last year and 13 percent above October 1983. This is the highest October placement total since 1978. NET PLACEMENTS of 2.69 million for October were 11 percent above last year and 14 percent above October 1983.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 85 thousand head, compared with 110 thousand during October 1984 and 102 thousand during October 1983.
