CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 8 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed December 1 for the slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.88 million head, down 8 percent from a year ago but 1 percent above December 1, 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

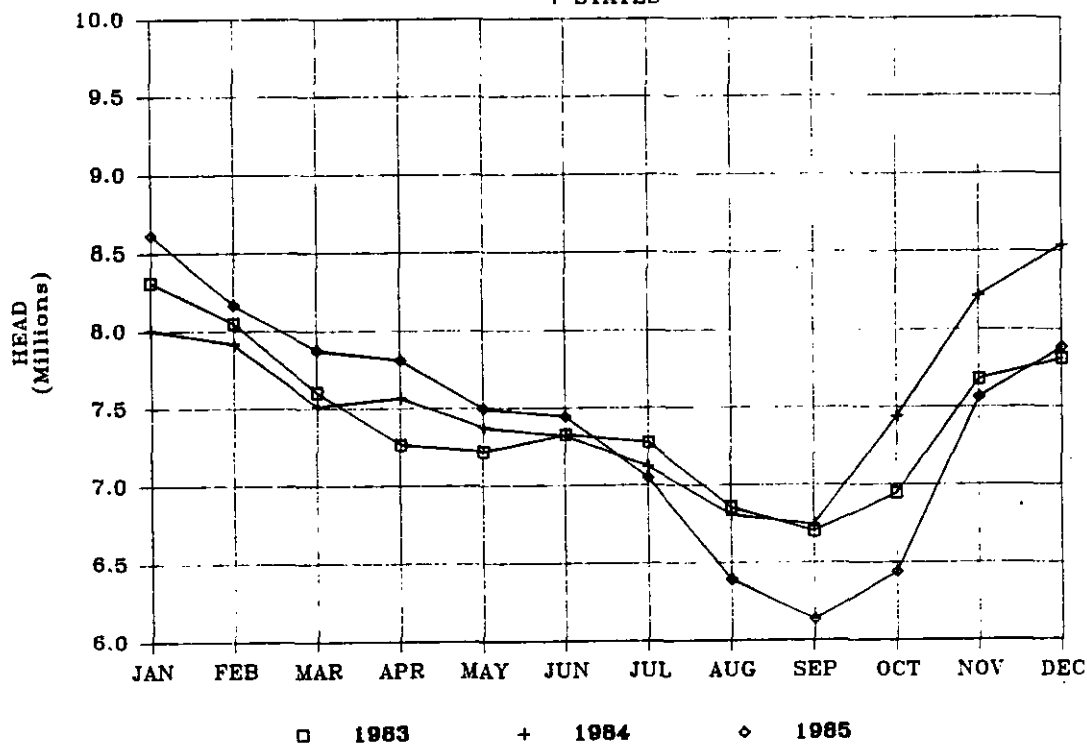
MARKETINGS of fed cattle during November totaled 1.38 million, a decrease of 8 percent from last year and 5 percent less than November 1983.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.78 million, down 9 percent from November 1984 but up 4 percent from two years ago. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.70 million were down 7 percent from 1984 but 7 percent above 1983.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 76 thousand compared with 121 thousand during November of 1984 and 1983.
