CATTLE ON FEED IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES DOWN 9 PERCENT

CATTLE AND CALVES ON FEED January 1, 1986, for the slaughter market in 13 quarterly States totaled 9.69 million head, 9 percent less than on January 1, 1985 and 2 percent below January 1, 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

The total feedlot inventory included 6.06 million steers and steer calves, down 11 percent from 1985 and 7 percent below the January 1, 1984 number. This group represented 62 percent of the total number on feed compared with 64 percent on January 1, 1985. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.58 million head, down 6 percent from last year but 7 percent above 1984.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the October - December 1985 quarter totaled 7.28 million head, 4 percent fewer than the same quarter in 1984 and virtually the same as the fourth quarter in 1983. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 324 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS for the October - December quarter of 1985 at 6.95 million head.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during October - December 1985 totaled 5.19 million head, a decrease of 6 percent from fourth quarter marketings in 1984 and 4 percent below marketings in 1983.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JANUARY - MARCH DOWN 2 PERCENT

During the first quarter of 1986, 5.81 million head of fed cattle are expected to be marketed. This would be a 2 percent decrease from first quarter marketings in 1985 but 2 percent above 1984.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 9 PERCENT

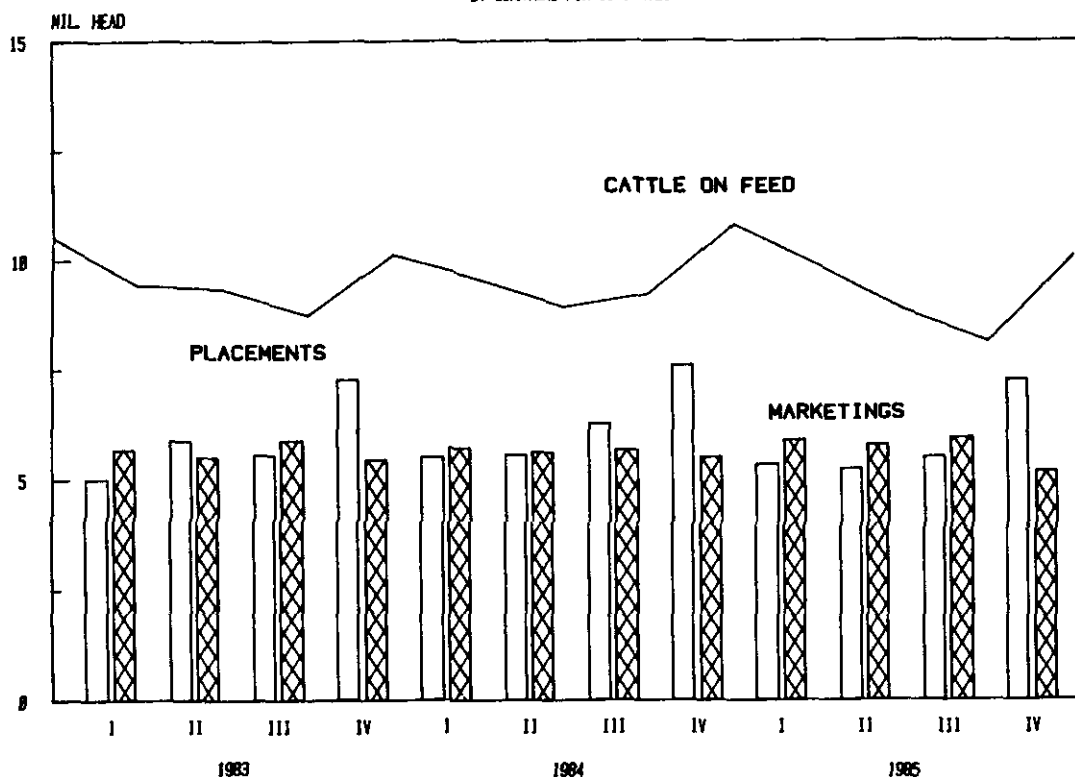
The number of cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1986, in the 7 monthly States was 7.86 million head, 9 percent below last year and 2 percent lower than 1984. Cattle on feed numbers were up 1 percent in Nebraska but down 27 and 24 percent in California and Iowa, respectively. PLACEMENTS during December of 1.48 million head were down 11 percent from 1984. MARKETINGS during December 1985 totaled 1.40 million head, down 2 percent from 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE in December amounted to 111 thousand head compared with 137 thousand in 1984.

THE OCTOBER - DECEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS in the 7 States totaled 4.32 million head, 6 percent less than the previous year and 5 percent fewer than the same quarter in 1983. Marketings in the 7 States during the October - December quarter accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED MARKETINGS in the 7 States during January - March 1986 are 4.83 million head, down 1 percent from the same quarter in 1985 but 1 percent above the marketings during the comparable quarter of 1984.
