## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 7 PERCENT

Cattle and calves on feed February 1 for the slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.62 million head, down 7 percent from a year ago and 4 percent below February 1, 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

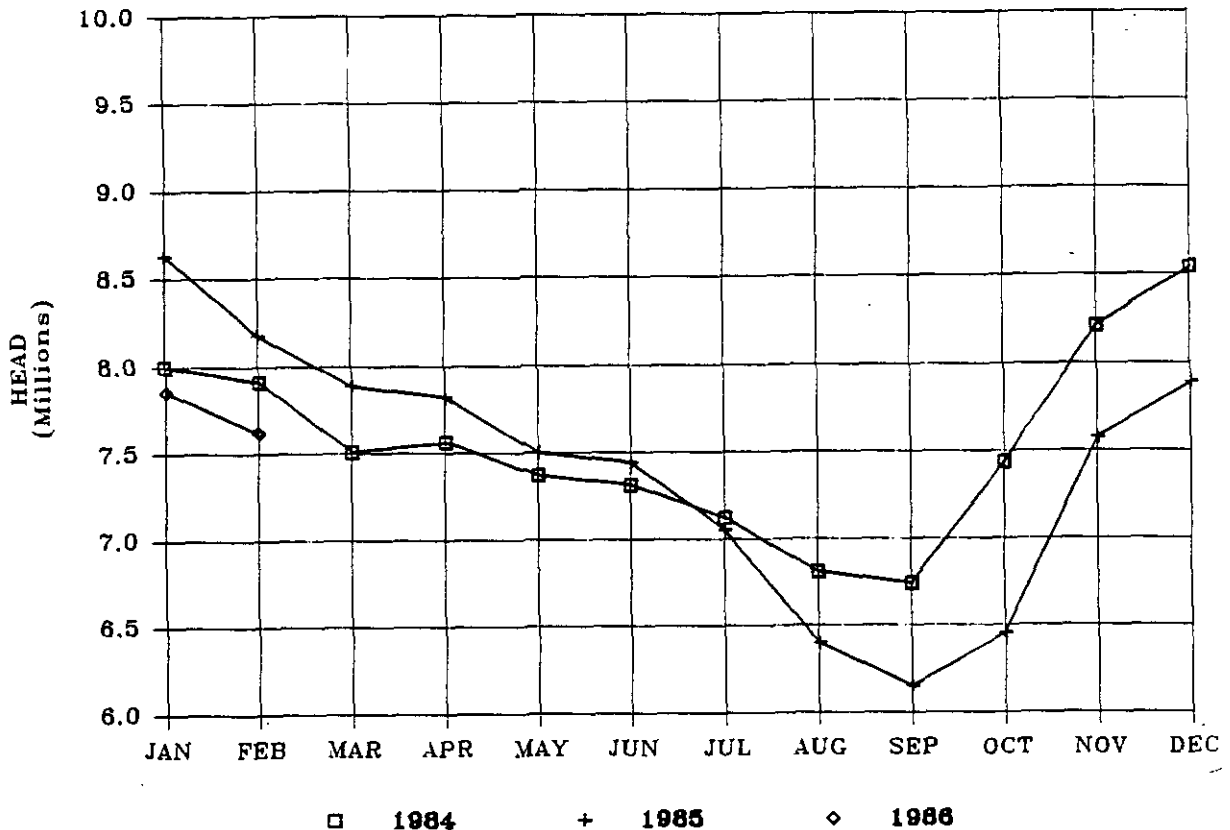
MARKETINGS of fed cattle during January totaled 1.74 million, a decrease of 2 percent from last year but 11 percent more than January 1984.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States were 1.58 million, up 9 percent from January 1985 and up 1 percent from two years ago. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.50 million were up 13 percent from 1985 and 2 percent above 1984.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 77 thousand compared with 118 thousand during January of 1985 and 86 thousand two years ago.
