CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 8 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1, 1986 for the slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 8.92 million head, down 8 percent from a year earlier and down 5 percent from April 1, 1984, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. The cattle on feed inventory included 5.58 million steers and steer calves, down 6 percent from both last year and April 1, 1984. Steers and steer calves made up 63 percent of the inventory total for April 1, 1986 compared with 62 percent last year and 64 percent on April 1, 1984. Heifers and heifer calves numbered 3.29 million head on April 1, showing a decrease of 11 percent from a year ago and 2 percent from April 1, 1984.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves into feedlots during the January-March 1986 quarter totaled 5.26 million head, down 1 percent from the same quarter last year, and 5 percent below the first quarter of 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 316 thousand head leaving NET PLACEMENTS of 4.94 million head.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during the January-March 1986 quarter totaled 5.72 million head, down 3 percent from the corresponding quarter last year and virtually the same as the comparable 1984 quarter.

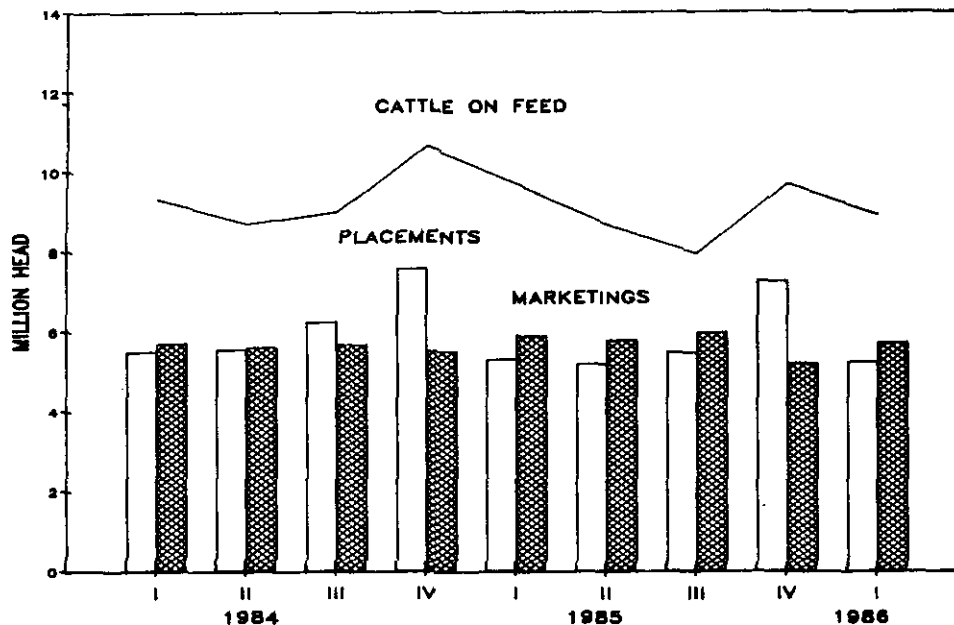
EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE DOWN 1 PERCENT

Cattle feeders intend to market 5.73 million head during the April-June quarter of 1986. This would be a decrease in marketings of 1 percent from the April-June quarter of 1985 but an increase of 2 percent from the comparable quarter of 1984.

CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS BY QUARTERS FOR 13 STATES



7 MONTHLY STATES CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 7 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1986, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.26 million head, 7 percent below April 1, 1985, and 4 percent below April 1, 1984. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March 1986, at 1.65 million head, increased 4 percent from last year but were 6 percent below March 1984. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.56 million, up fractionally from March 1985 but 2 percent below March 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 86 thousand head compared with 98 thousand last year and 117 thousand in 1984.

The January-March quarterly marketings, at 4.77 million head, were down 2 percent from the comparable quarter last year and down fractionally from the first quarter of 1984. The January-March marketings in the 7 States accounted for 83 percent of the 13-State total. Expected marketings for the April-June 1986 quarter are estimated at 4.79 million head, compared with 4.78 million during 1985.
