CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 8 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1986 for slaughter market in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 7.95 million head, down 8 percent from July 1 last year and 9 percent less than two years ago, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. On feed numbers were the lowest for this date since 1975.

The cattle on feed inventory included 4.91 million steers and steer calves, down 7 percent from a year ago and 11 percent below 1984. This group represented 62 percent of the total July 1 number on feed compared with 61 percent in 1985. Heifers and heifers calves, at 3.01 million, were down 11 percent from last year and 5 percent from 1984.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June quarter totaled 5.18 million, down slightly from last year, 7 percent below 1984 and lowest for this comparable period since 1975. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 375 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS AT 4.81 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 5.77 million, down slightly from the same quarter last year, but 3 percent above 1984.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER DOWN 5 PERCENT

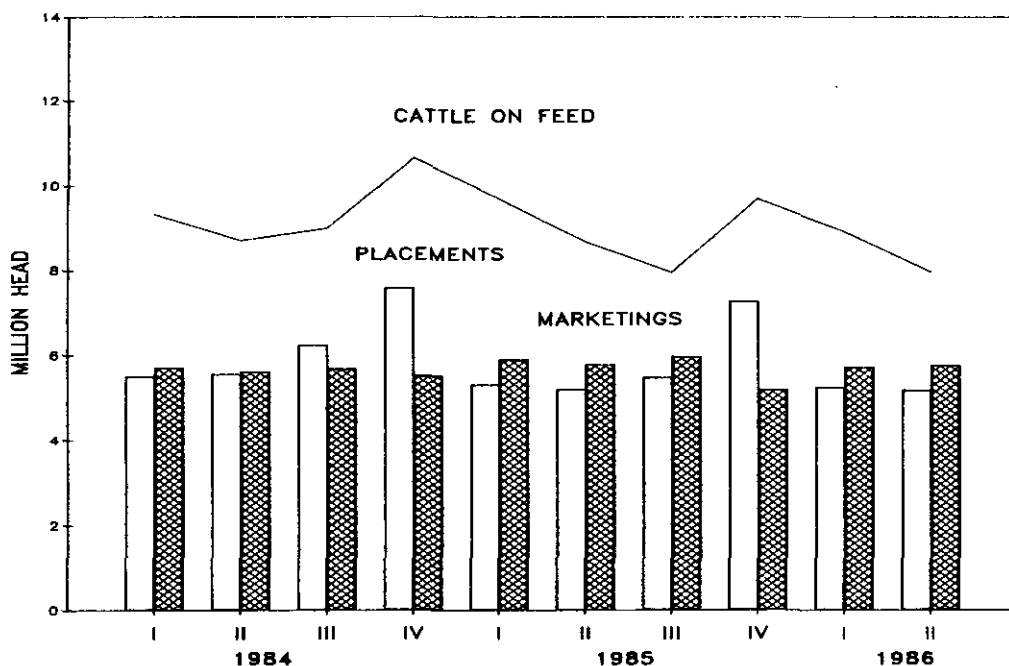
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.66 million head during the July-September quarter of 1986. This would be 5 percent less than the third quarter marketings in 1985 and slightly below 1984.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 8 PERCENT

Cattle on feed July 1, 1986 in the 7 monthly States totaled 6.52 million, 8 percent below the previous year and 1984. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during June, of 1.14 million, were 10 percent below last year's level and 21 percent below June 1984. MARKETINGS during June totaled 1.63 million, 3 percent above 1985, and 5 percent above 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during June was 67 thousand head, 23 percent below last year and 29 percent below 1984.

The APRIL-JUNE QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.86 million, were up 2 percent from last year and 3 percent above the same quarter in 1984. Marketings for the 7 States during the April-June quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the July-September 1986 quarter are estimated at 4.77 million, down 4 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1985 but 1 percent above 1984.
