CATTLE ON FEED UP 3 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed October 1, 1986 for slaughter in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 8.20 million head, up 3 percent from October 1 last year but 9 percent below 1984, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.18 million steers and steer calves, 6 percent above last year but 8 percent below 1984. This group represented 63 percent of the total October number on feed compared with 62 percent in 1985. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 2.99 million, down 1 percent from last year and 11 percent below 1984.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the July-September quarter totaled 6.33 million, up 15 percent from last year and 1 percent above the comparable period in 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 233 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 6.09 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-September totaled 5.85 million, 2 percent less than the same quarter a year ago but 3 percent above 1984.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER UP 3 PERCENT

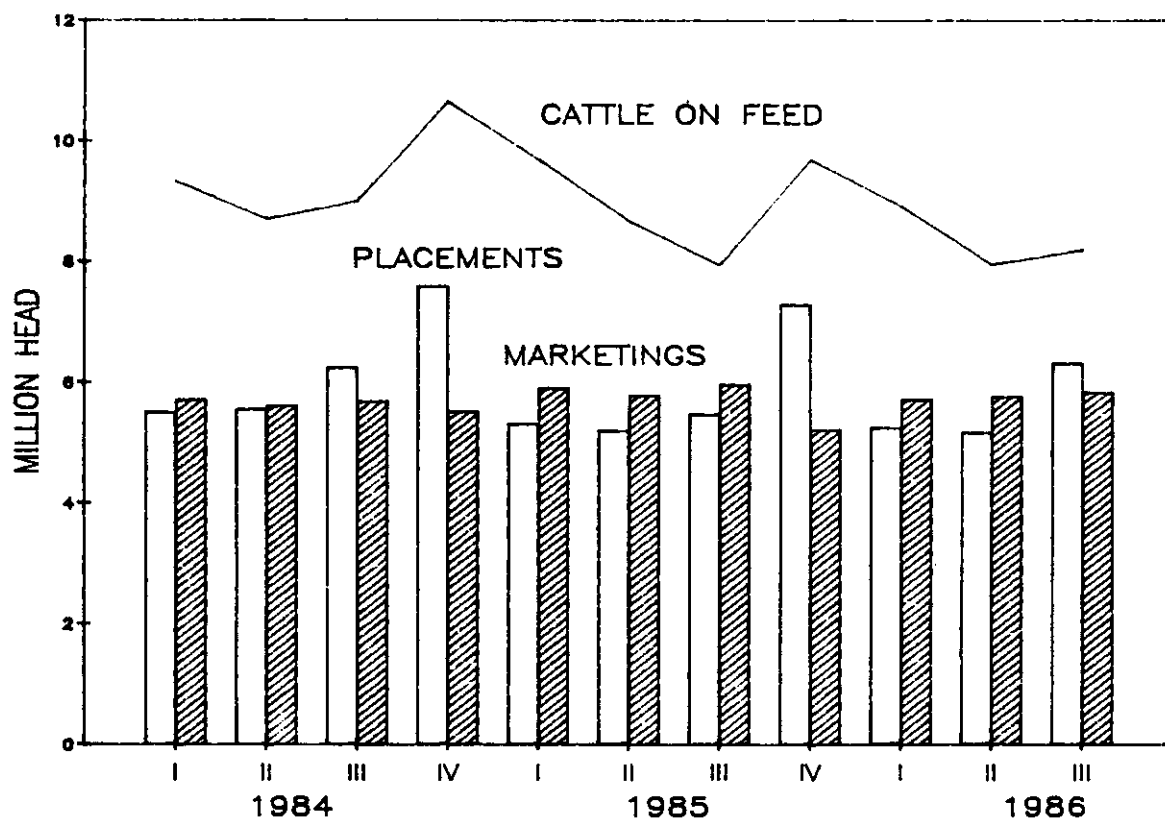
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.40 million head during the October-December quarter of 1986. This would be 3 percent above the fourth quarter marketings in 1985 but 2 percent below 1984.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 5 PERCENT

Cattle on feed October 1, 1986 in the 7 monthly States totaled 6.81 million, 5 percent above the previous year, but 8 percent below two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during September, of 2.08 million, were 5 percent above last year but 8 percent below 1984. MARKETINGS during September totaled 1.62 million, 1 percent above 1985 and 9 percent above 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September was 59 thousand head, 25 percent below last year and 27 percent below 1984.

The JULY-SEPTEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.96 million, was down fractionally from last year but 5 percent above 1984. Marketings for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 85 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the October-December 1986 quarter are estimated at 4.55 million, up 4 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1985 but 1 percent below 1984.
