CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN FRACTIONALLY FROM LAST YEAR

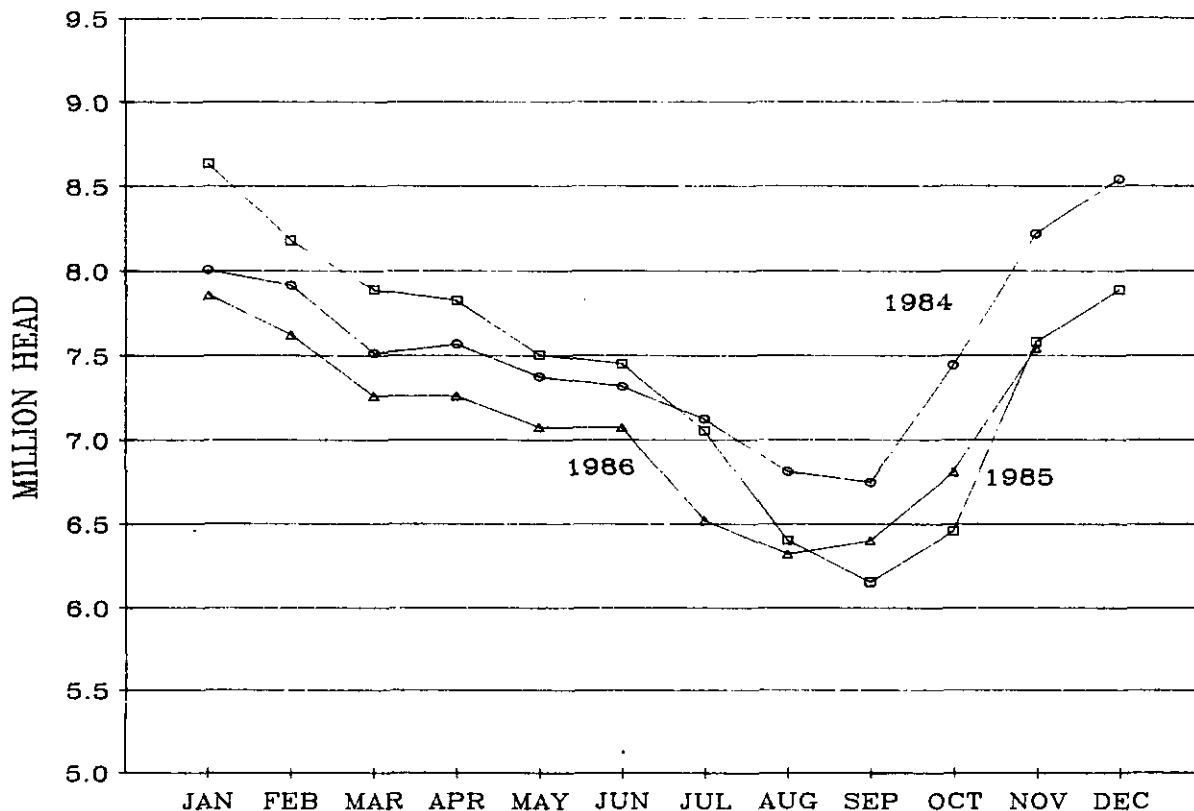
Cattle and calves on feed November 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.55 million head, down fractionally from a year ago and 8 percent below November 1, 1984, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during October totaled 1.59 million, 1 percent above last year but 4 percent less than October two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October totaled 2.40 million, down 14 percent from last year and 6 percent below October 1984. This is the lowest October placement total since 1981. NET PLACEMENTS of 2.32 million for October are 14 percent below last year and down 5 percent from two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 81 thousand head, compared with 85 thousand during October 1985 and 110 thousand during October 1984.
