## CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 5 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1987 for slaughter in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 9.24 million head, down 5 percent from January 1 last year and 13 percent below 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is the lowest January 1 number on feed since 1982.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.96 million steers and steer calves, 2 percent below last year and 12 percent below 1985. This group represented 65 percent of the total January number on feed compared with 62 percent in 1986. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.24 million, down 10 percent from last year and 15 percent below 1985.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the October-December quarter totaled 6.73 million, down 9 percent from last year and 11 percent below the comparable period in 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 312 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 6.41 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during October-December totaled 5.38 million, 3 percent more than the same quarter a year ago but 3 percent below 1984.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JANUARY-MARCH DOWN 3 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.57 million head during the January-March quarter of 1987. This would be 3 percent below the first quarter marketings in 1986 and 6 percent below 1985.

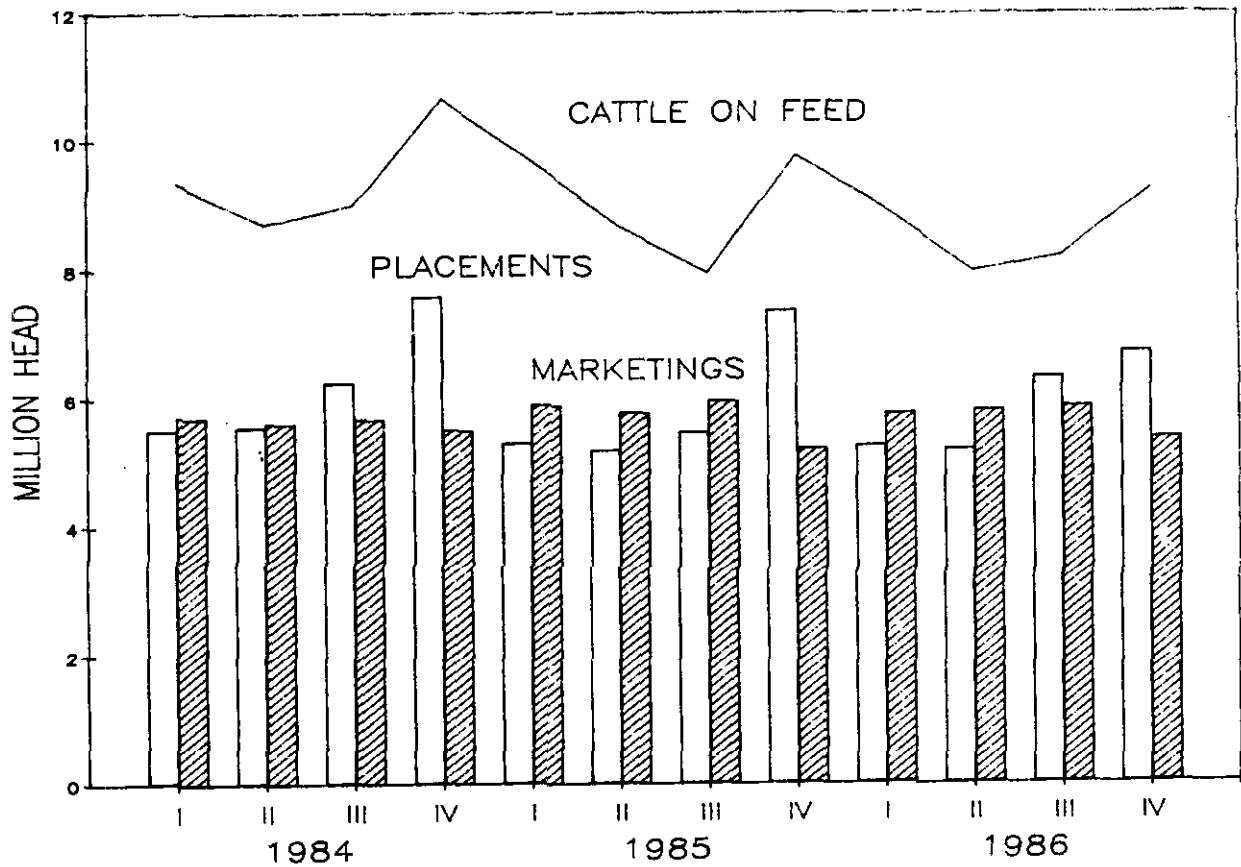
## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT

Cattle on feed January 1, 1987 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.63 million, 4 percent below the previous year, and 12 percent below two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during December, of 1.41 million, were 9 percent below last year and 15 percent below 1984. MARKETINGS during December totaled 1.49 million, 7 percent above 1985 and 5 percent above 1984. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during December was 104 thousand head, 6 percent below last year and 24 percent below 1984.

The OCTOBER-DECEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.53 million, were up 4 percent from last year but 1 percent below 1984. Marketings for the 7 States during the October-December quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the January-March 1987 quarter are estimated at 4.72 million, down 2 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1986 and 3 percent below 1985.
