CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 5 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

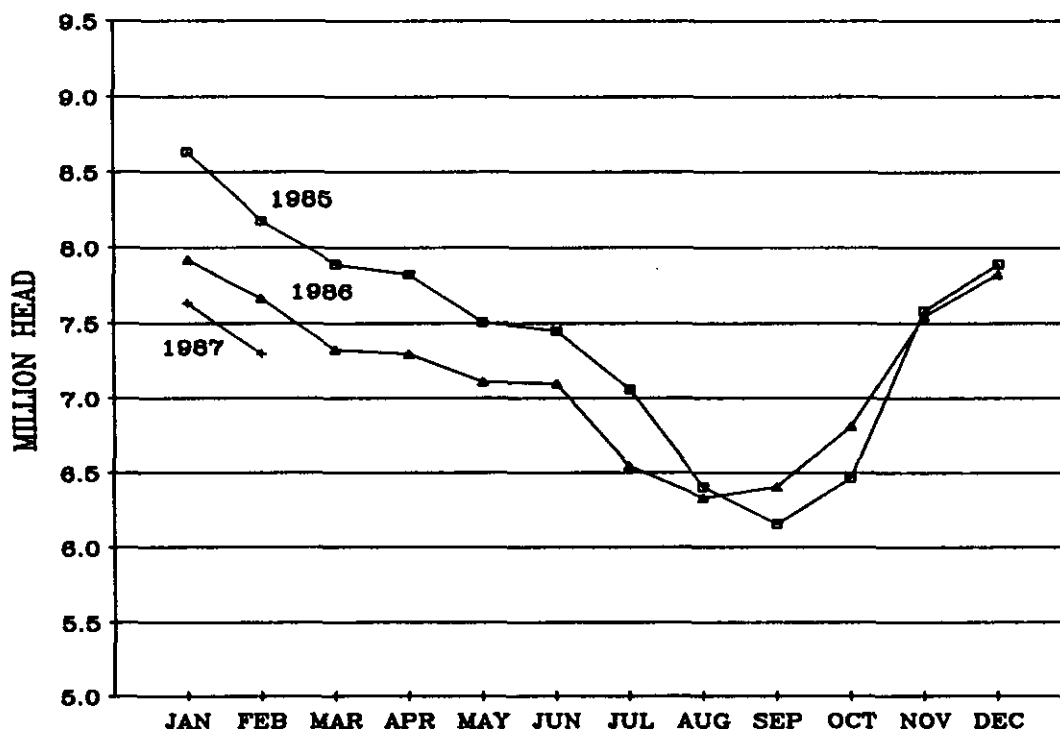
Cattle and calves on feed February 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.29 million head, down 5 percent from a year ago and 11 percent below February 1, 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during January totaled 1.77 million, 1 percent above last year but 1 percent less than January two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during January totaled 1.56 million, down 1 percent from last year but 8 percent above January 1985. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.43 million for January are 4 percent below last year but 8 percent above January two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 127 thousand head, compared with 87 thousand during January 1986 and 118 thousand during January 1985.
