CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 2 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1, 1987 for slaughter in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 8.80 million head, down 2 percent from April 1 last year and 9 percent below 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is the lowest April 1 number on feed since 1981.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.70 million steers and steer calves, 2 percent above last year but 4 percent below 1985. This group represented 65 percent of the total April number on feed compared with 63 percent in 1986. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.06 million, down 7 percent from a year ago and 17 percent below April 1, 1985.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the January-March quarter totaled 5.70 million, up 8 percent from last year and 7 percent above the comparable period in 1985. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 371 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.33 million.

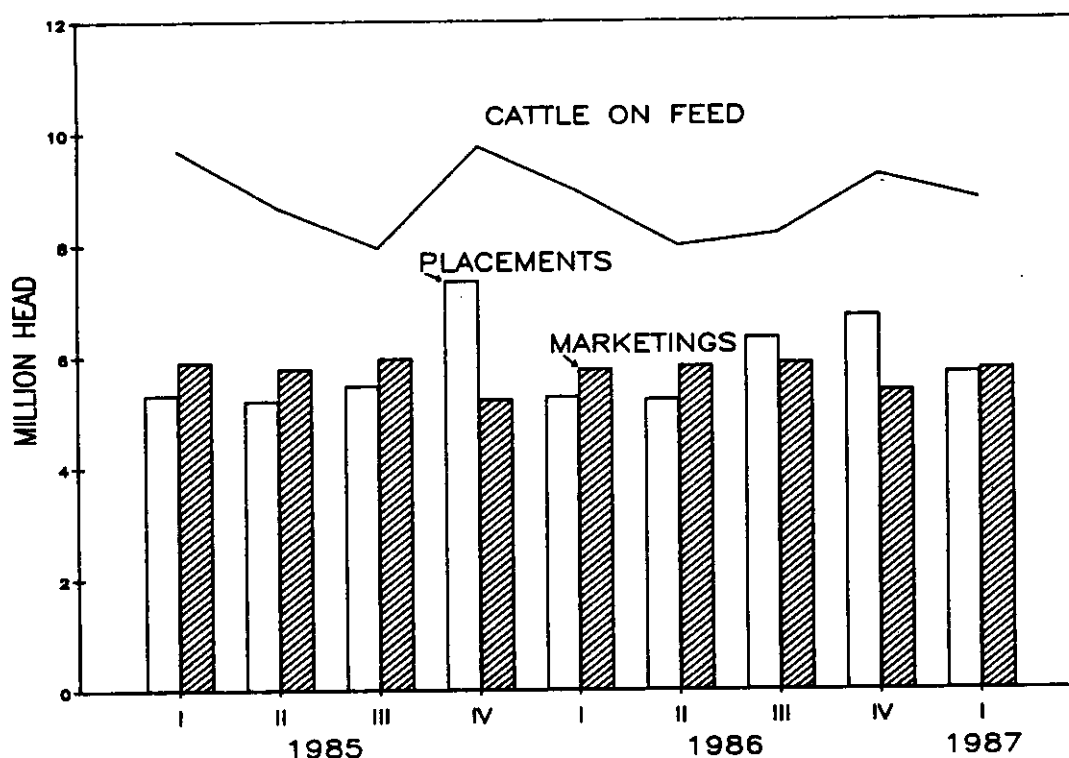
MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 5.77 million, about the same as a year ago but 2 percent below 1985.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE DOWN 7 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 5.44 million head during the April-June quarter of 1987. This would be 7 percent below the second quarter marketings in 1986 and 6 percent below 1985.

CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS BY QUARTERS FOR 13 STATES



CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 1 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1987 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.22 million, 1 percent below the previous year, and 8 percent below two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during March totaled 1.75 million, 6 percent above last year and 10 percent above 1985. MARKETINGS during March totaled 1.59 million, about the same as 1986 and 2 percent above 1985. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 89 thousand head, 3 percent above last year but 9 percent below 1985.

The JANUARY-MARCH QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.86 million, were up 1 percent from last year but about the same as 1985. Marketings for the 7 States during the January-March quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the April-June 1987 quarter are estimated at 4.60 million, down 6 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1986 and 4 percent below 1985.
