CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 6 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

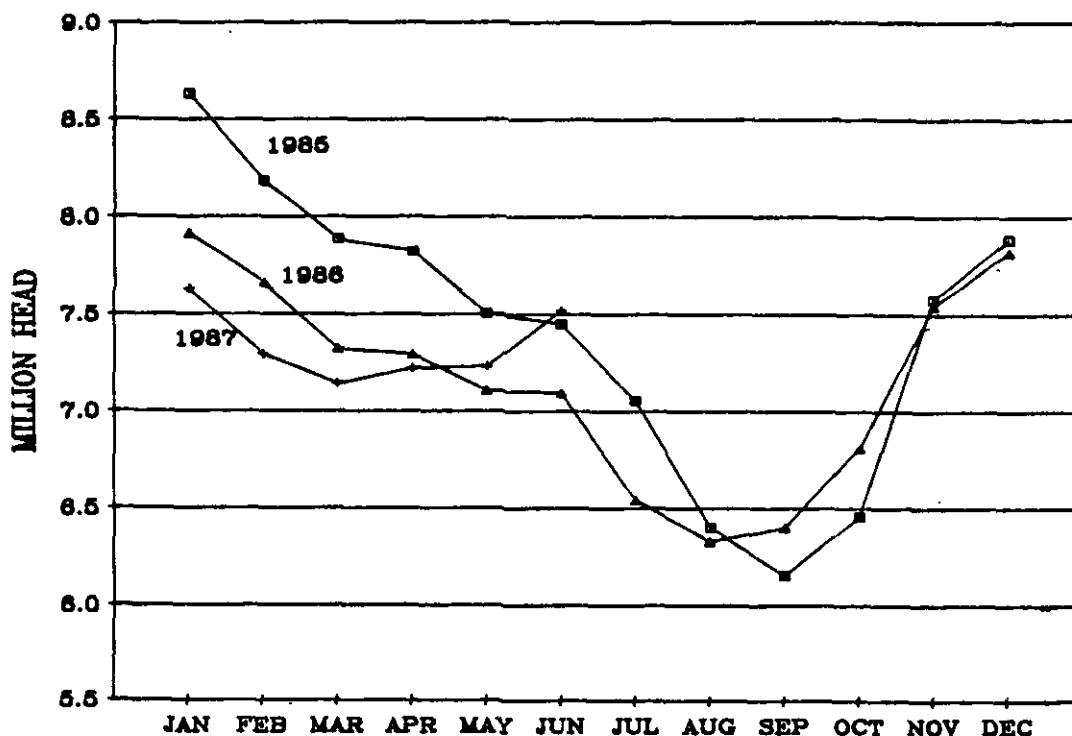
Cattle and calves on feed June 1 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.52 million head, up 6 percent from a year ago and 1 percent above June 1, 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during May totaled 1.52 million, down 7 percent from last year and 5 percent less than May two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during May totaled 1.95 million, up 11 percent from last year and 17 percent above May 1985. This is the highest May placement total since 1978. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.81 million for May are 12 percent above last year and 17 percent above May two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 143 thousand head, compared with 132 thousand during May 1986 and 128 thousand during May 1985.
