CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 6 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

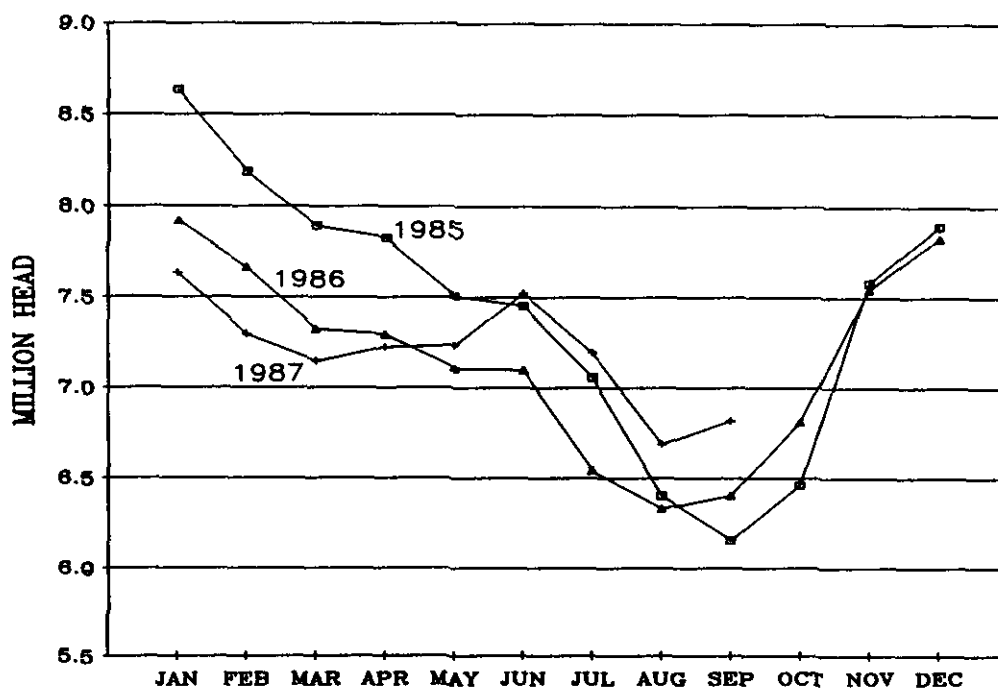
Cattle and calves on feed September 1, 1987 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.82 million head, up 6 percent from a year ago and 11 percent above September 1, 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during August totaled 1.70 million, 2 percent above last year and fractionally above August two years ago making this the largest August total since 7 State estimates were begun in 1972.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during August totaled 1.90 million, up 5 percent from last year, 26 percent above August 1985, and the largest number of August placements since 1972. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.83 million for August are 6 percent above last year and 26 percent above August two years ago.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 68 thousand head, compared with 70 thousand during August 1986 and 62 thousand during August 1985.
