CATTLE ON FEED UP 10 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed October 1, 1987 for slaughter in the 13 Quarterly States totaled 8.99 million head, up 10 percent from October 1 last year and 13 percent above 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.90 million steers and steer calves, 14 percent above last year and 20 percent above 1985. This group represented 66 percent of the total October number on feed compared with 63 percent in 1986. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.06 million, up 2 percent from both a year ago and 1985.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the July-September quarter totaled 6.56 million, up 3 percent from last year and 20 percent above the comparable period in 1985. This is the largest third quarter placements since 1978. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 245 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 6.31 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-September totaled 5.99 million, 2 percent more than a year ago and slightly above 1985.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER UP 3 PERCENT

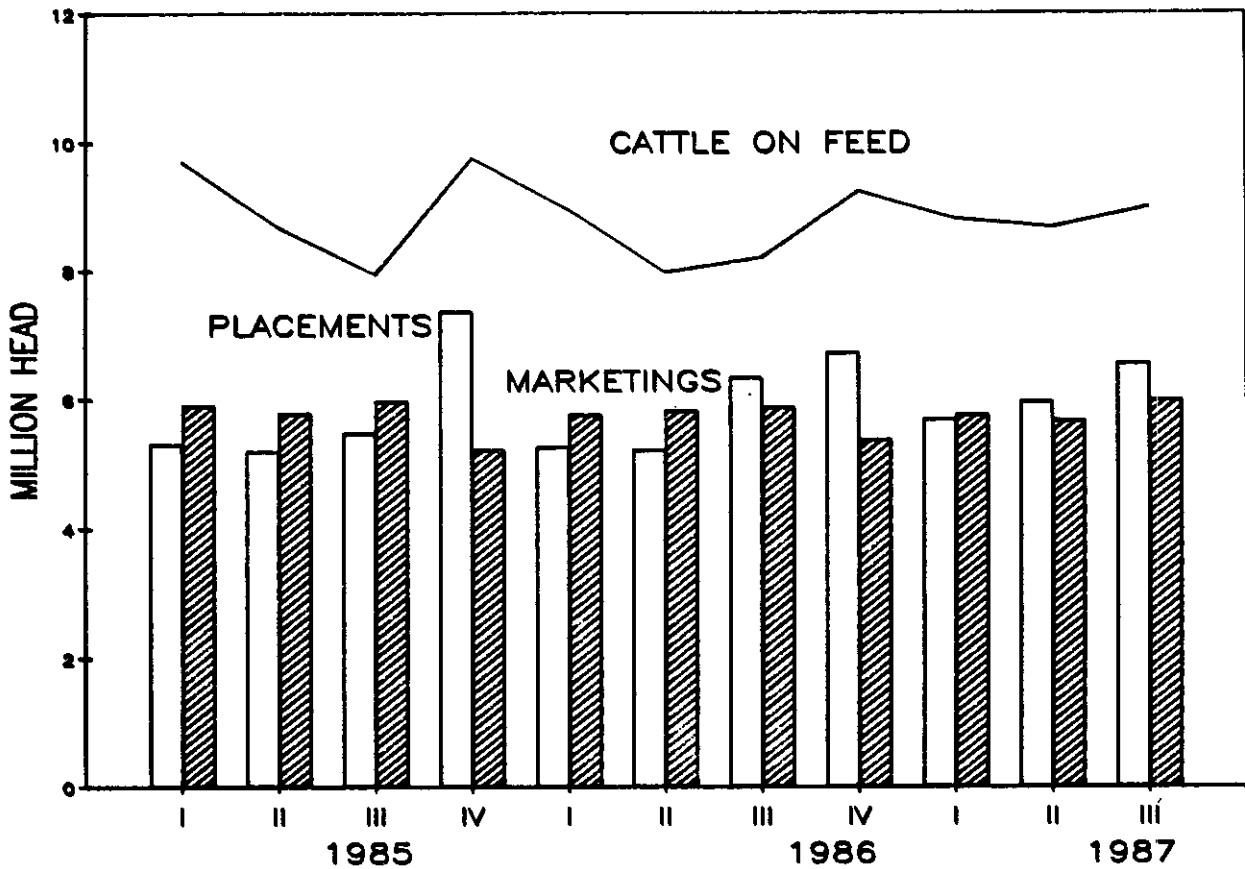
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.51 million head during the October-December quarter of 1987. This would be 3 percent more than the fourth quarter marketings in 1986 and 6 percent more than in 1985.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 11 PERCENT

Cattle on feed October 1, 1987 in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.54 million, 11 percent more than the previous year, and 17 percent more than two years ago. PLACEMENTS in feedlots during September totaled 2.42 million, 15 percent above last year and 22 percent above 1985. MARKETINGS during September totaled 1.64 million, unchanged from September 1986 but 2 percent above 1985. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during September was 71 thousand head, 20 percent above last year but 10 percent below 1985.

The JULY-SEPTEMBER QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 5.03 million were up 1 percent from both last year and 1985. Marketings for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13-State total. EXPECTED 7-STATE MARKETINGS for the October-December 1987 quarter are estimated at 4.64 million, up 2 percent from the corresponding quarter of 1986 and 7 percent above 1985.
