CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 11 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

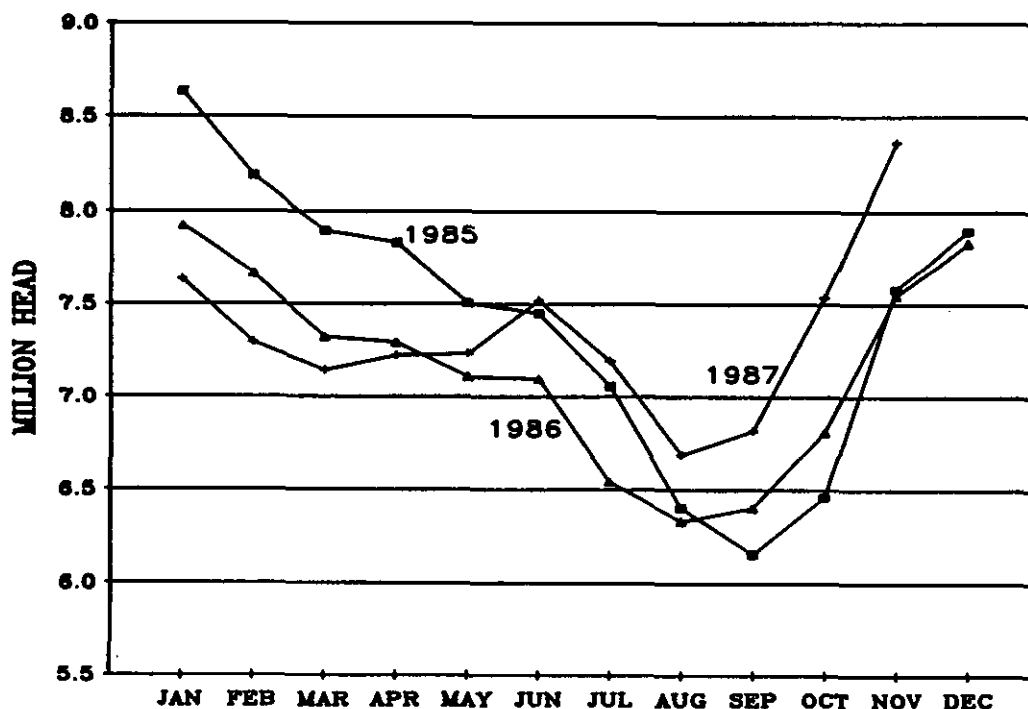
Cattle and calves on feed November 1, 1987 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.36 million head, up 11 percent from a year ago and 10 percent above November 1, 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is the largest November number on feed since 1978.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during October totaled 1.69 million, 6 percent above last year and 7 percent above October two years ago. This is the largest number of October marketings since 1978.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October totaled 2.60 million, up 8 percent from last year but down 6 percent from October 1985. NET PLACEMENTS of 2.52 million for October are 8 percent above last year but 6 percent below 1985.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 85 thousand head, and compares with 81 thousand during October 1986 and is equal to the other disappearance during October 1985.
