## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 7 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

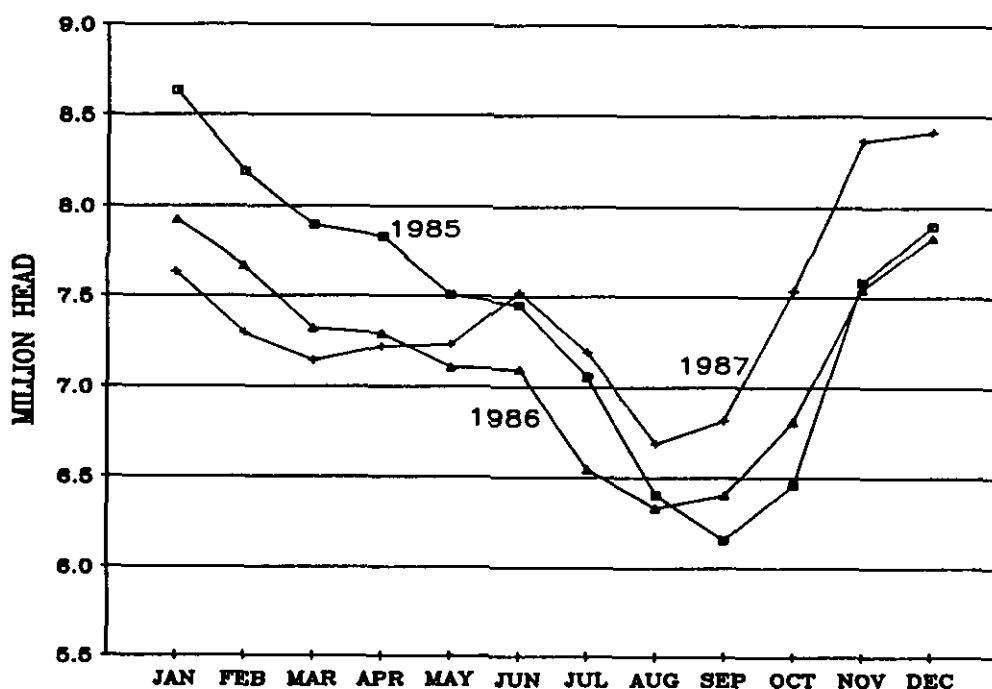
Cattle and calves on feed December 1, 1987 for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.41 million head, up 7 percent from both a year ago and December 1, 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during November totaled 1.46 million, 1 percent above last year and 6 percent above November two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during November totaled 1.61 million, down 11 percent from last year and down 9 percent from November 1985. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.51 million for November are 13 percent below last year and 11 percent below 1985.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 103 thousand head, compared with 87 thousand during November 1986 and 76 thousand during November 1985.
