CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 4 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1989, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 9.41 million head, down 4 percent from January 1, 1988 but 2 percent above 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 6.03 million steers and steer calves, 6 percent below last year but 1 percent above 1987. This group represented 64 percent of the total January number on feed, compared to 65 percent for both last year and 1987. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.33 million, nearly the same as a year ago but up 3 percent from 1987.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the October-December 1988 quarter totaled 6.65 million, down 1 percent from last year and 2 percent below the comparable period in 1986. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 347 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 6.30 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during October-December totaled 5.49 million, 2 percent below 1987 but 2 percent above the same period in 1986.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JANUARY-MARCH DOWN 2 PERCENT

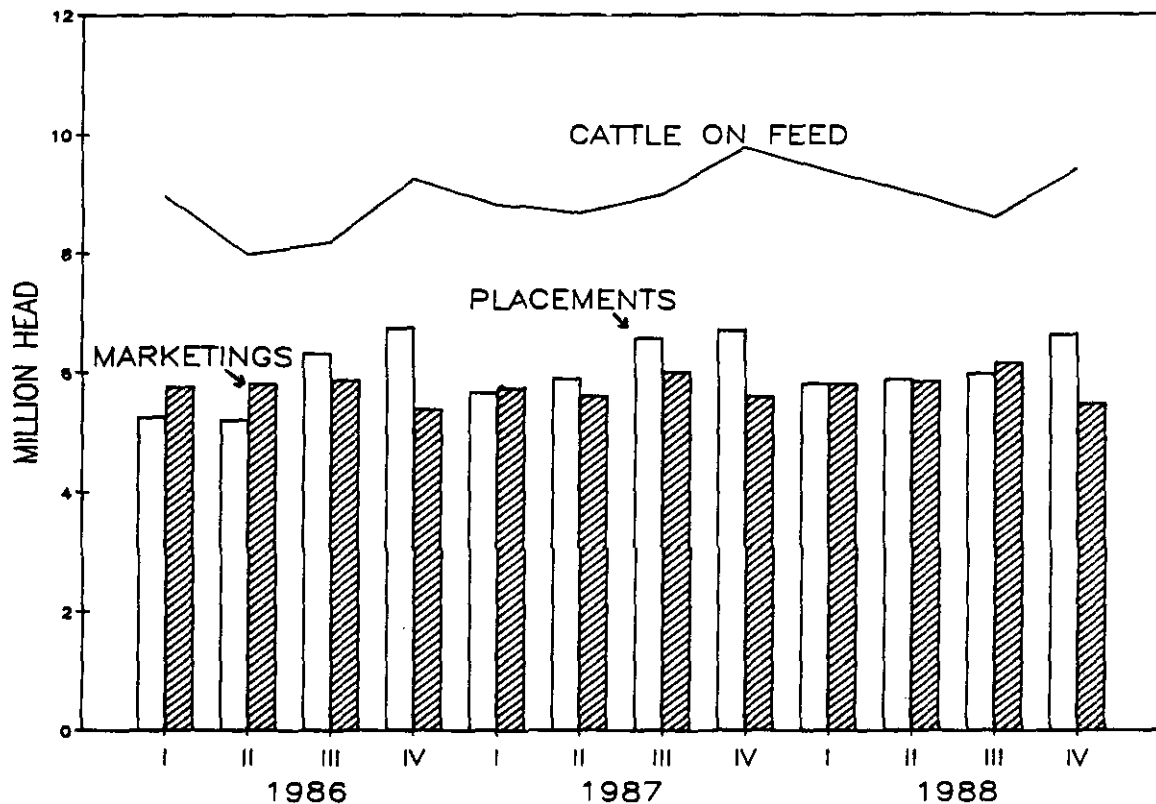
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.73 million head during the January-March quarter of 1989. This would be down 2 percent from the first quarter marketings in 1988 and down fractionally from 1987.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 4 PERCENT

Cattle on feed January 1, 1989, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.77 million, 4 percent less than the previous year but 2 percent more than two years ago. Placements in feedlots during December totaled 1.40 million, 5 percent more than last year but 2 percent below 1986. Marketings during December totaled 1.52 million, down 3 percent from December 1987 but up fractionally from 1986. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during December was 115 thousand head, 3 percent below last year but 11 percent above 1986.

The October-December QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.63 million, were 2 percent less than 1987 but 2 percent above 1986. Marketings for the 7 states during the October-December quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13 state total. Expected 7 State MARKETINGS for the January-March 1989 are estimated at 4.82 million, down 1 percent from 1988 and down fractionally from 1987.
