## CATTLE ON FEED UP 3 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed April 1, 1989, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 9.68 million head, up 3 percent from April 1, 1988, and 10 percent above 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 6.19 million steers and steer calves, 1 percent above last year and 8 percent above 1987. This group represented 64 percent of the total April number on feed, compared to 65 percent for both last year and 1987. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.45 million, 6 percent above a year ago and up 13 percent from 1987.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the January-March 1989 quarter totaled 6.21 million, up 7 percent from last year and 9 percent above the comparable period in 1987. This is the largest first quarter placements in the last 18 years. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 344 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 5.87 million.

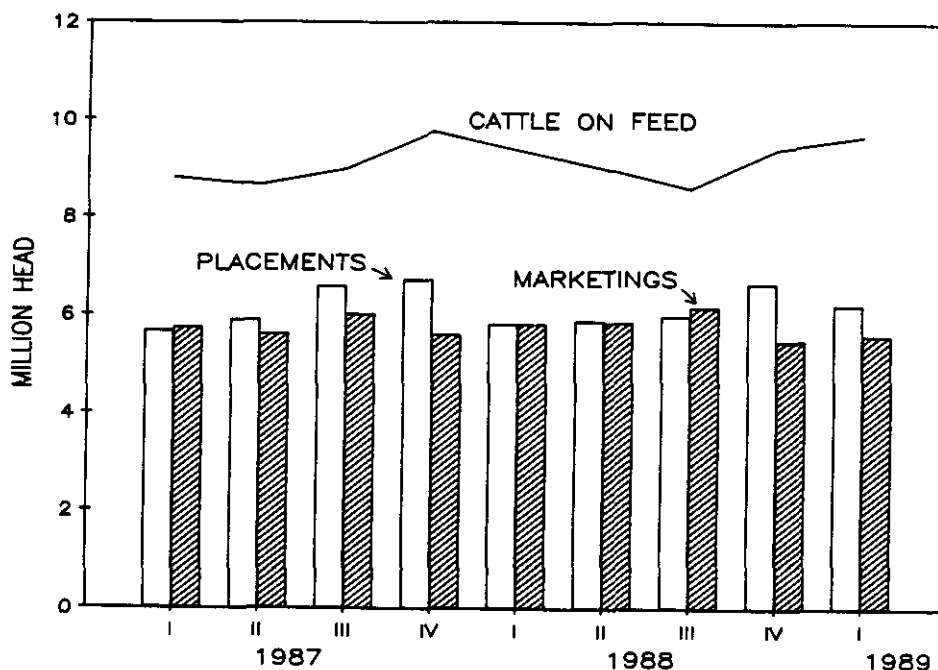
MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during January-March totaled 5.60 million, 4 percent below 1988 and 3 percent below the same period in 1987.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR APRIL-JUNE UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 6.09 million head during the April-June quarter of 1989. This would be up 4 percent from the second quarter marketings in 1988 and up 8 percent from 1987.

## CATTLE ON FEED, PLACEMENTS, MARKETINGS BY QUARTERS FOR 13 STATES



### CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 3 PERCENT

Cattle on feed April 1, 1989, in the 7 monthly States totaled 8.01 million, 3 percent more than the previous year and 11 percent more than two years ago. This is the largest April 1 number on feed since 1978. Placements in feedlots during March totaled a record 1.98 million, 7 percent more than last year and 15 percent above 1987. Marketings during March totaled 1.55 million, down 2 percent from March 1988 and 1 percent below March 1987. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during March was 75 thousand head, 29 percent below last year and 16 percent below 1987.

The January-March QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 4.73 million, were 3 percent less than 1988 and 2 percent below 1987. Marketings for the 7 states during the January-March quarter accounted for 84 percent of the 13 state total. Expected 7 State MARKETINGS for the April-June 1989 quarter are estimated at 5.18 million, up 3 percent from last year and 9 percent above 1987.
