## CATTLE ON FEED DOWN 6 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1989, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 8.46 million head, down 6 percent from July 1, 1988, and down 2 percent from 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.31 million steers and steer calves, 8 percent below last year and 5 percent below 1987. This group represented 63 percent of the total July number on feed, compared to 64 percent last year and 65 percent in 1987. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.10 million, 3 percent below a year ago but up 2 percent from 1987.

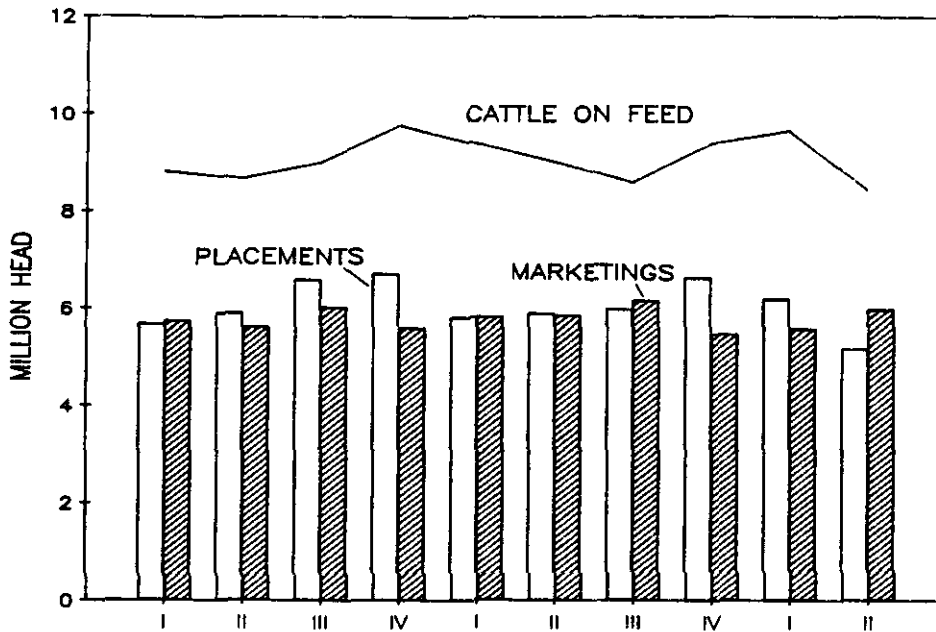
PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June 1989 quarter totaled 5.18 million, down 12 percent from the comparable period in both 1988 and 1987. This is the smallest second quarter placements since 1975. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE of 415 thousand head leaves NET PLACEMENTS at 4.76 million, compared with 5.48 in 1988.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 5.99 million, 2 percent above 1988 and 7 percent above the same period in 1987.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER DOWN 2 PERCENT

Cattle feeders expect to market 6.04 million head during the July-September quarter of 1989. This would be down 2 percent from the third quarter marketings in 1988 and fractionally above 1987.

### CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES DOWN 6 PERCENT

Cattle on feed July 1, 1989, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.01 million, 6 percent below the previous year and 3 percent less than two years ago. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.27 million, 8 percent less than last year and 11 percent below 1987. Marketings during June totaled 1.75 million, up 3 percent from both June 1988 and June 1987. OTHER DISAPPEARANCE during June was 62 thousand head, 9 percent below last year and 29 percent below 1987.

The April-June QUARTERLY MARKETINGS for the 7 States, at 5.07 million, were 1 percent more than 1988 and 7 percent above 1987. Marketings for the 7 states during the April-June quarter accounted for 85 percent of the 13 state total. Expected 7 State MARKETINGS for the July-September 1989 quarter are estimated at 5.08 million, down 2 percent from last year but fractionally above 1987.
