CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES DOWN 3 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

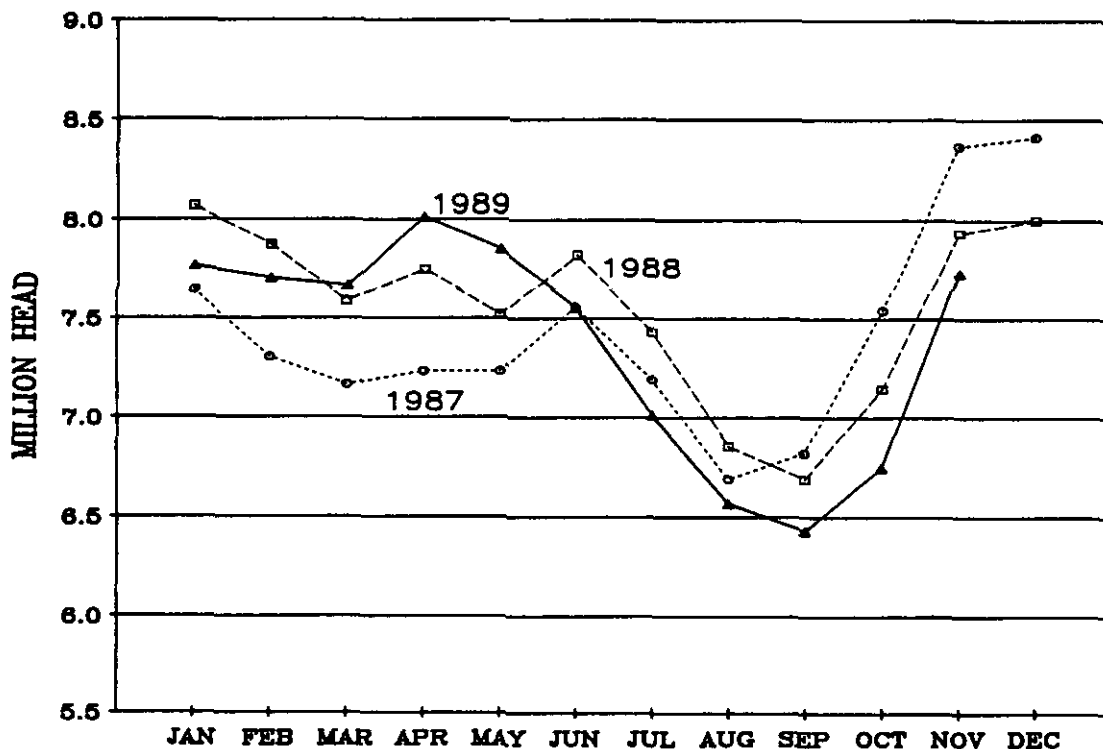
Cattle and calves on feed November 1, 1989, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.73 million head, down 3 percent from a year ago and 8 percent below November 1, 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during October totaled 1.63 million, up 2 percent from last year but 4 percent below two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October totaled 2.68 million, up 8 percent from last year and 3 percent above October 1987. **NET PLACEMENTS** of 2.61 million for October is 9 percent above last year and 3 percent above 1987.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 71 thousand head compared to 84 thousand in October 1988 and 85 thousand in October 1987.
