## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 2 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

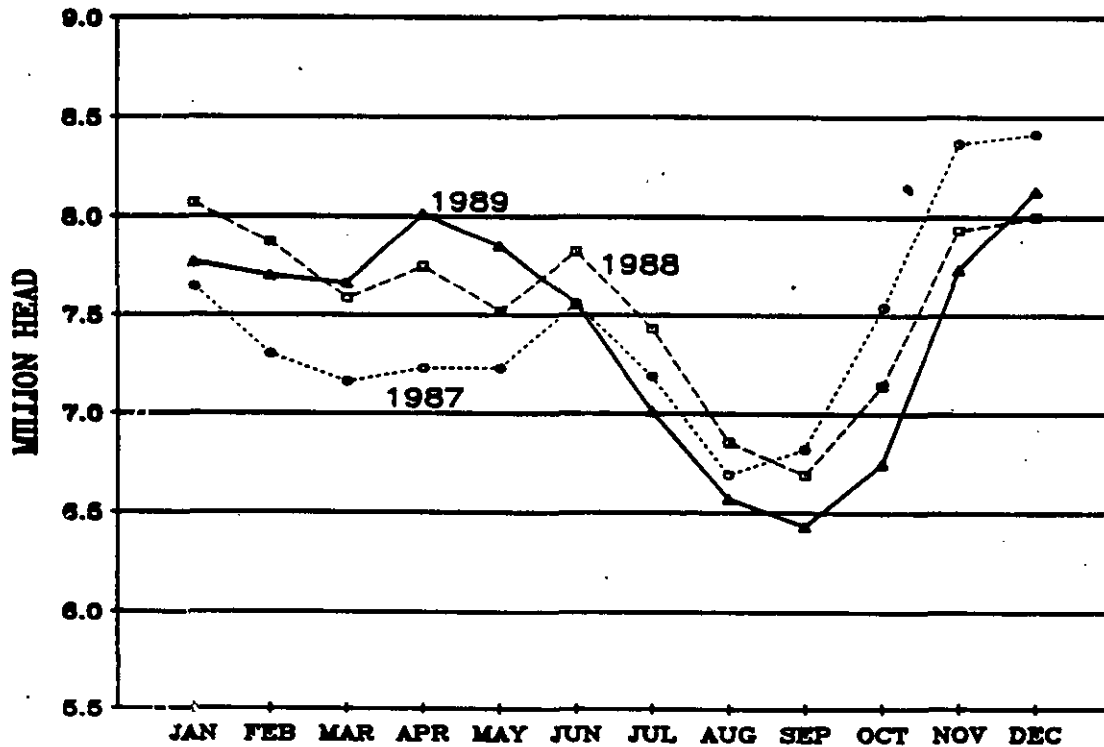
Cattle and calves on feed December 1, 1989, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.13 million head, up 2 percent from a year ago but 3 percent below December 1, 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during November totaled 1.50 million, fractionally below last year but 1 percent above two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during November totaled 1.99 million, up 18 percent from last year and 22 percent above November 1987. This is the largest November placement total since 1977, and the result of cattle moving into feedlots rather than going onto wheat pastures. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.90 million for November is 20 percent above last year and 24 percent above 1987.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 91.0 thousand head compared to 107 thousand in November 1988 and 103 thousand in November 1987.
