CATTLE ON FEED UP 3 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed January 1, 1990, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 9.94 million head, up 3 percent from January 1, 1989, but down 2 percent from 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 6.46 million steers and steer calves, 4 percent above last year but 2 percent below 1988. This group represented 65 percent of the total January number on feed, compared to 64 percent last year and 65 percent in 1988. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.44 million, fractionally above a year ago but 1 percent below 1988.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the October-December 1989 quarter totaled 7.32 million, up 10 percent from 1988 and 7 percent above 1987. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** of 293 thousand head leaves **NET PLACEMENTS** at 7.03 million, compared with 6.30 million in 1988.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during October-December totaled 5.36 million, 2 percent below 1988 and 5 percent below the same period in 1987.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JANUARY-MARCH UP FRACTIONALLY

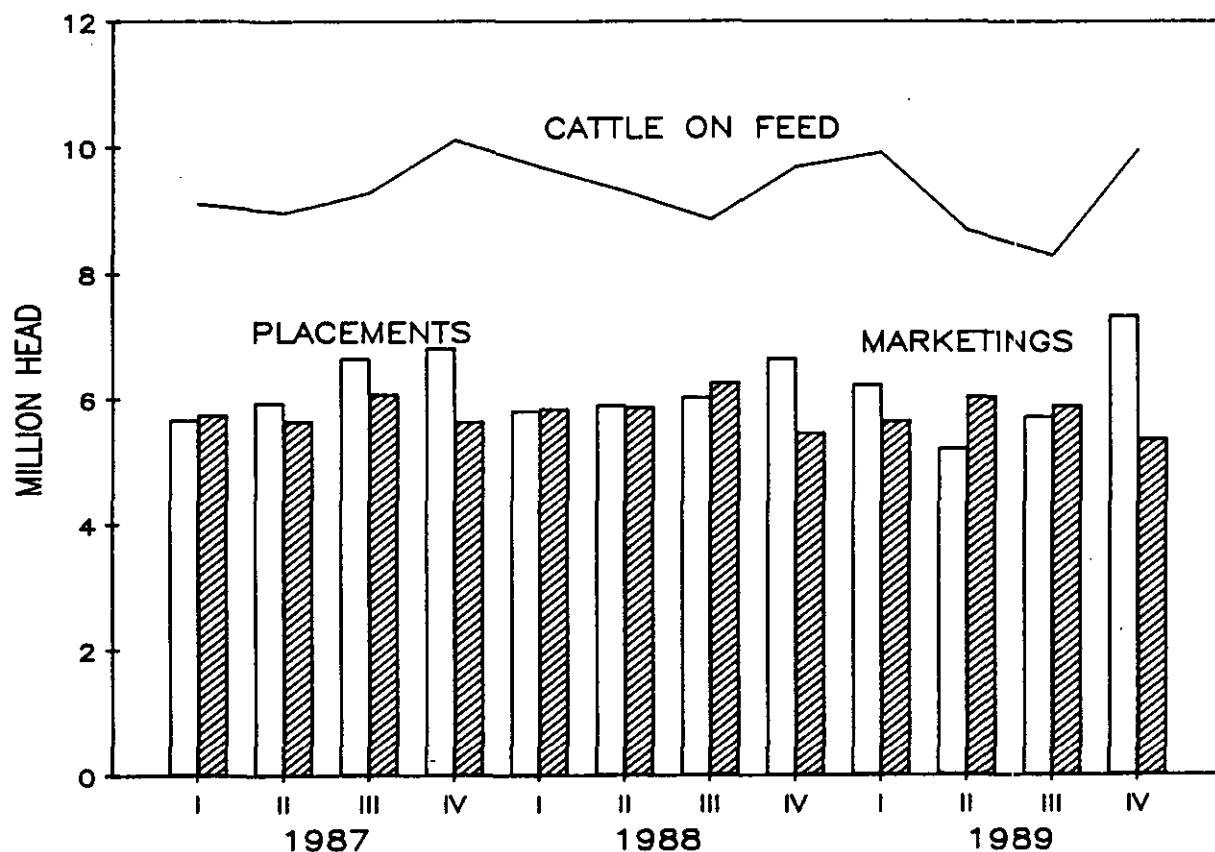
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.69 million head during the January-March quarter of 1990. This would be up fractionally from the first quarter marketings in 1989 but 3 percent below 1988.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 4 PERCENT

Cattle on feed January 1, 1990, in the 7 monthly States totaled 8.38 million head, 4 percent above the previous year and down slightly from two years ago. Placements in feedlots during December totaled 1.55 million, 9 percent greater than 1988 and 12 percent above 1987. Marketings during December totaled 1.42 million, down 6 percent from a year ago and 12 percent below December 1987. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** during December was 87 thousand head, 24 percent below last year and 27 percent below 1987.

The October-December **QUARTERLY MARKETINGS** for the 7 States, at 4.54 million, were 2 percent below 1988 and 5 percent lower than 1987. Marketings for the 7 states during the October-December quarter accounted for 85 percent of the 13 state total. Expected 7 State **MARKETINGS** for the January-March 1990 quarter are estimated at 4.82 million, up 1 percent from last year but down 2 percent from 1988.
