CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 STATES UP 7 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

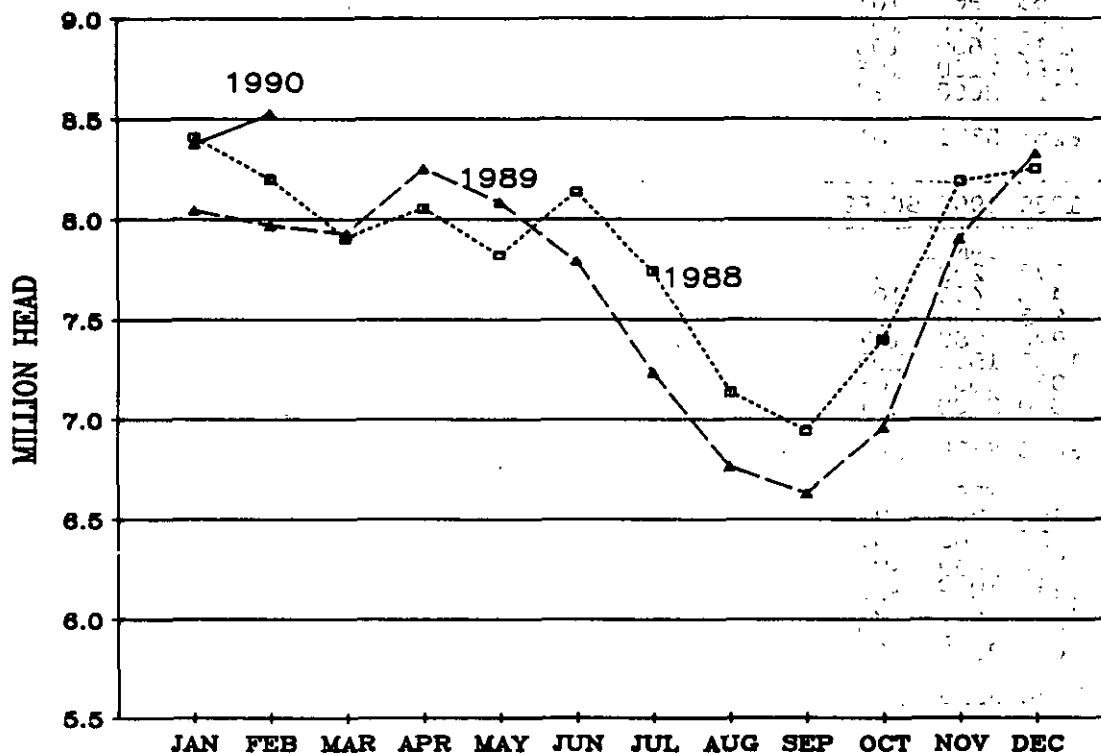
Cattle and calves on feed February 1, 1990, for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.53 million head, up 7 percent from a year ago and 4 percent above February 1, 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is the largest February on feed total since 1979.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle during January totaled 1.63 million, down 3 percent from last year and 7 percent below two years ago.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during January totaled 1.90 million, up 11 percent from last year and 14 percent above January 1988. This is the second largest placement total in January for the 7 States. NET PLACEMENTS of 1.78 million for January is 11 percent above last year and 14 percent above 1988.

OTHER DISAPPEARANCE totaled 114 thousand head compared to 104 thousand in January 1989 and 106 thousand in January 1988.
