## CATTLE ON FEED UP 1 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed July 1, 1990, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 8.76 million head, up 1 percent from July 1, 1989, but 6 percent below 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.63 million steers and steer calves, 3 percent above last year but 6 percent below 1988. This group represented 64 percent of the total July number on feed, compared to 63 percent last year and 64 percent in 1988. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.09 million; 3 percent below last year and 6 percent below 1988.

**PLACEMENTS** of cattle and calves on feed during the April-June 1990 quarter totaled 5.11 million, down 2 percent from 1989 and 14 percent below 1988. This is the lowest April-June placement total since 1975. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** of 400 thousand head leaves **NET PLACEMENTS** at 4.71 million.

**MARKETINGS** of fed cattle for slaughter during April-June totaled 6.01 million, slightly below 1989 but 2 percent above the same period in 1988.

## EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR JULY-SEPTEMBER UP SLIGHTLY

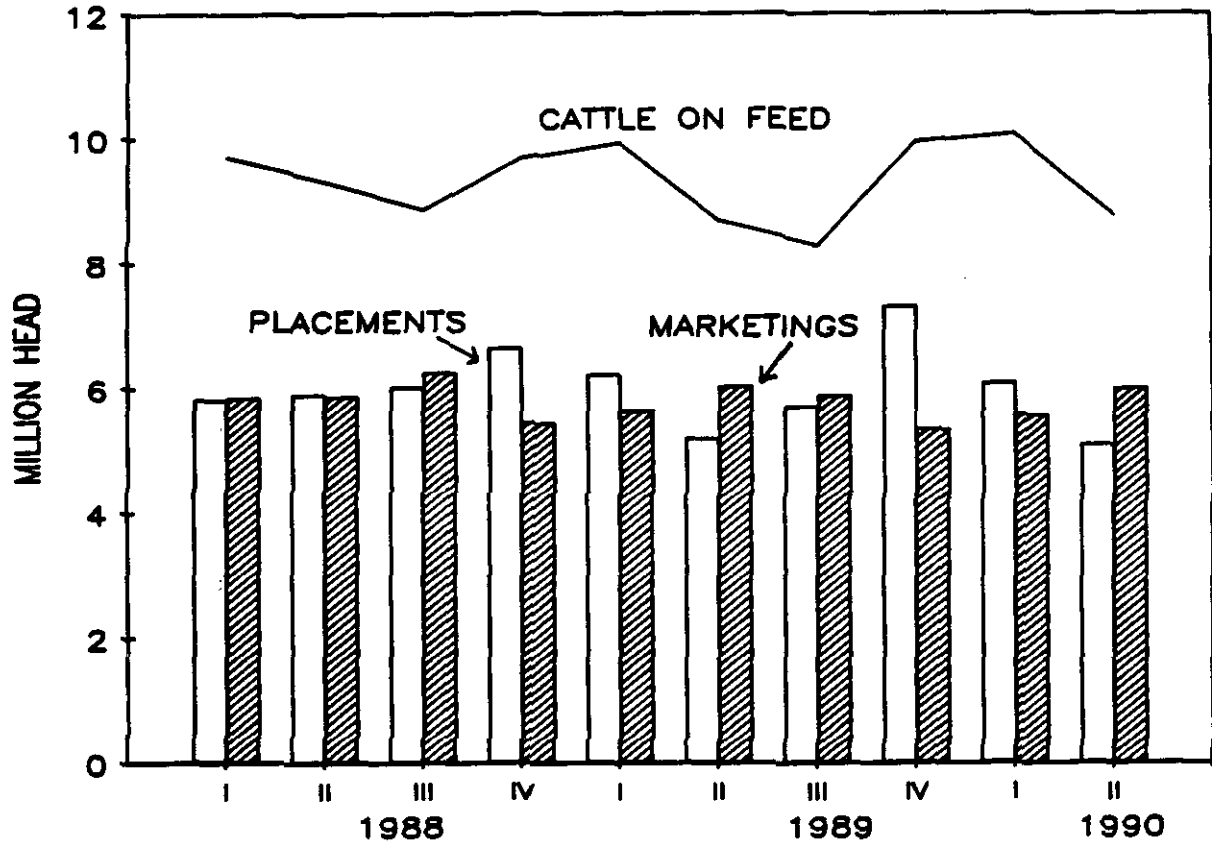
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.95 million head during the July-September quarter of 1990. This would be up 1 percent from the third quarter marketings in 1989 but 5 percent below 1988.

## CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 1 PERCENT

Cattle on feed July 1, 1990, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.31 million, 1 percent above the previous year but 6 percent below two years ago. Placements in feedlots during June totaled 1.34 million, 4 percent above 1989 but 3 percent below 1988. Marketings during June totaled 1.82 million, up 2 percent from a year ago and 6 percent above June 1988. This is the highest 7 State June marketings on record. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** during June was 73 thousand head, 18 percent above last year and 7 percent above 1988.

The April-June **QUARTERLY MARKETINGS** for the 7 States, at 5.17 million, was up 1 percent from 1989 and 2 percent above 1988. Marketings for the 7 states during the April-June quarter accounted for 86 percent of the 13 state total. Expected 7 State **MARKETINGS** for the July-September 1990 quarter are estimated at 5.01 million, up 1 percent from last year but 5 percent below 1988.
