CATTLE ON FEED UP 10 PERCENT IN 13 QUARTERLY STATES

Cattle and calves on feed October 1, 1990, for slaughter market in the 13 quarterly States totaled 9.10 million head, up 10 percent from October 1, 1989, and 3 percent above 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board.

The cattle on feed inventory included 5.92 million steers and steer calves, 13 percent above last year and 3 percent above 1988. This group represented 65 percent of the total October number on feed, compared to 63 percent last year and 65 percent in 1988. Heifers and heifer calves accounted for 3.14 million, 5 percent above last year and 2 percent above 1988.

PLACEMENTS of cattle and calves on feed during the July-September 1990 quarter totaled 6.34 million, up 11 percent from 1989 and 5 percent above 1988. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** of 261 thousand head leaves **NET PLACEMENTS** at 6.08 million.

MARKETINGS of fed cattle for slaughter during July-Sept totaled 5.74 million, 3 percent below 1989 and 8 percent below the same period in 1988.

EXPECTED MARKETINGS FOR OCTOBER-DECEMBER UP 2 PERCENT

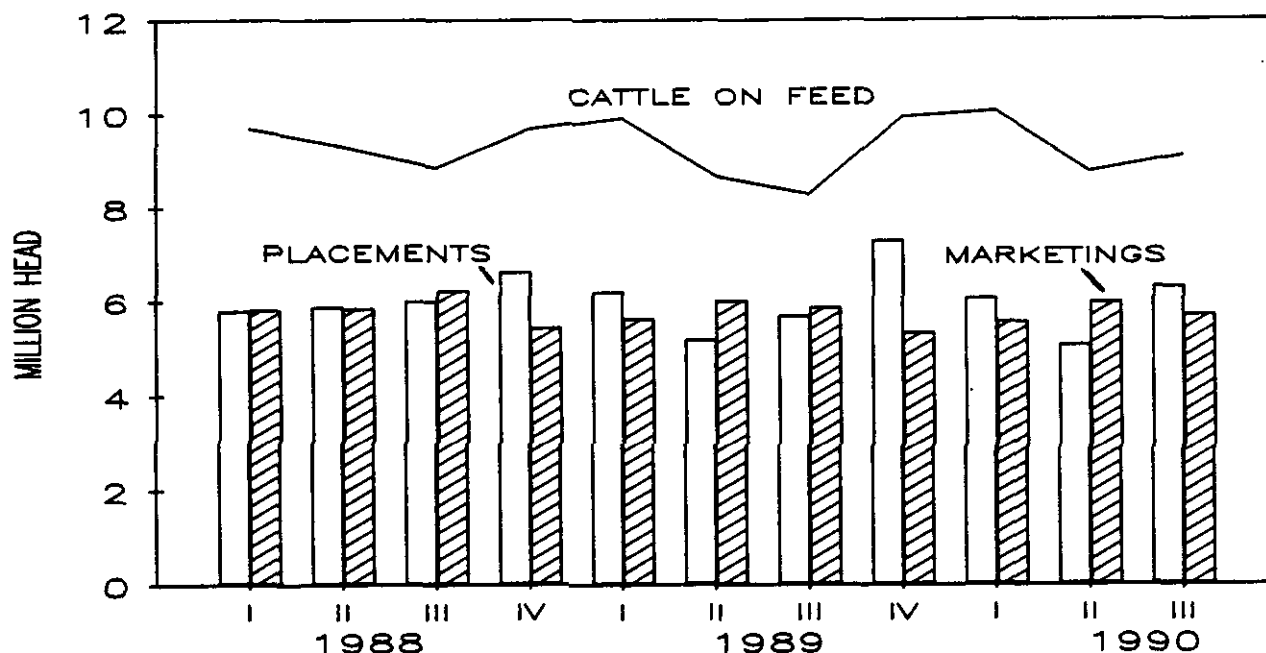
Cattle feeders expect to market 5.50 million head during the October-December quarter of 1990. This would be up 2 percent from the fourth quarter marketings in 1989 and 1 percent above 1988.

CATTLE ON FEED IN 7 MONTHLY STATES UP 10 PERCENT

Cattle on feed October 1, 1990, in the 7 monthly States totaled 7.68 million, 10 percent above the previous year and 4 percent above two years ago. Placements in feedlots during September totaled 2.21 million, 13 percent above 1989 and slightly above 1988. Marketings during September totaled 1.45 million, down 8 percent from a year ago and 14 percent below September 1988. This is the lowest 7 State September marketings since 1979. **OTHER DISAPPEARANCE** during September was 79 thousand head, 68 percent above last year and 18 percent above 1988.

The July-September **QUARTERLY MARKETINGS** for the 7 States, at 4.86 million, were down 2 percent from 1989 and 8 percent below 1988. Marketings for the 7 States during the July-September quarter accounted for 85 percent of the 13 State total. Expected 7 State **MARKETINGS** for the October-December 1990 quarter are estimated at 4.65 million, up 2 percent from last year and 1 percent above 1988.
