Cattle on Feed in 7 States Down 9 Percent From Last Year

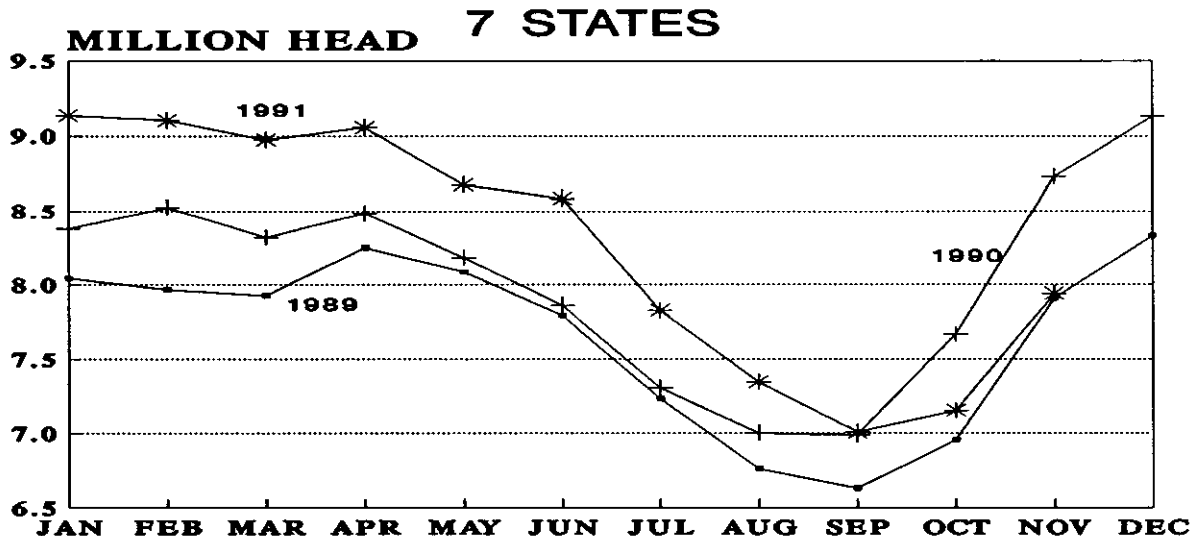
Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.94 million head, down 9 percent from a year ago but up slightly from November 1, 1989.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during October totaled 2.48 million, down 10 percent from last year, and 7 percent below October 1989. Net placements of 2.40 million for October were down 10 percent from last year and down 7 percent from 1989.

Marketings of fed cattle during October totaled 1.62 million, up 1 percent from last year but 1 percent below two years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 77,000 head compared to 87,000 in October 1990 and 71,000 in October 1989.
