Cattle on Feed Down 9 Percent in 7 Monthly States


Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.82 million head, down 9 percent from a year ago and 4 percent below May 1,1990.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during April totaled 1.44 million, up 1 percent from last year and 5 percent above 1990. **Net placements** of 1.31 million for April were up 1 percent from last year and 6 percent above 1990.

Marketings of fed cattle during April totaled 1.50 million, down 9 percent from last year and 3 percent below two years ago. This is the lowest April marketings since 1983.

Other disappearance totaled 125,000 head compared to 128,000 in April 1991, and 125,000 in April 1990.
