Cattle on Feed Down 1 Percent in 7 Monthly States

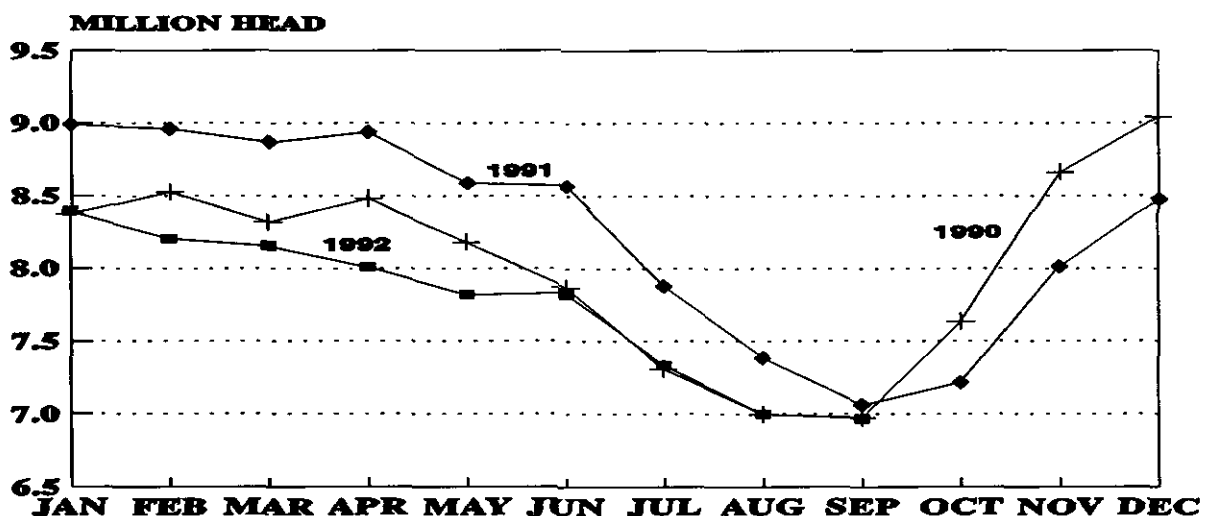
Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 6.97 million head, down 1 percent from a year ago and down fractionally from September 1, 1990.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during August totaled 1.64 million, up 12 percent from last year but 6 percent below 1990. Net placements of 1.56 million for August were also up 12 percent from last year but 6 percent below 1990.

Marketings of fed cattle during August totaled 1.59 million, down 7 percent from last year and 6 percent below two years ago. This is the lowest August marketings since 1981.

Other disappearance totaled 81,000 head compared to 67,000 in August 1991 and 82,000 in August 1990.
