## Cattle on Feed Up 7 Percent in 7 Monthly States

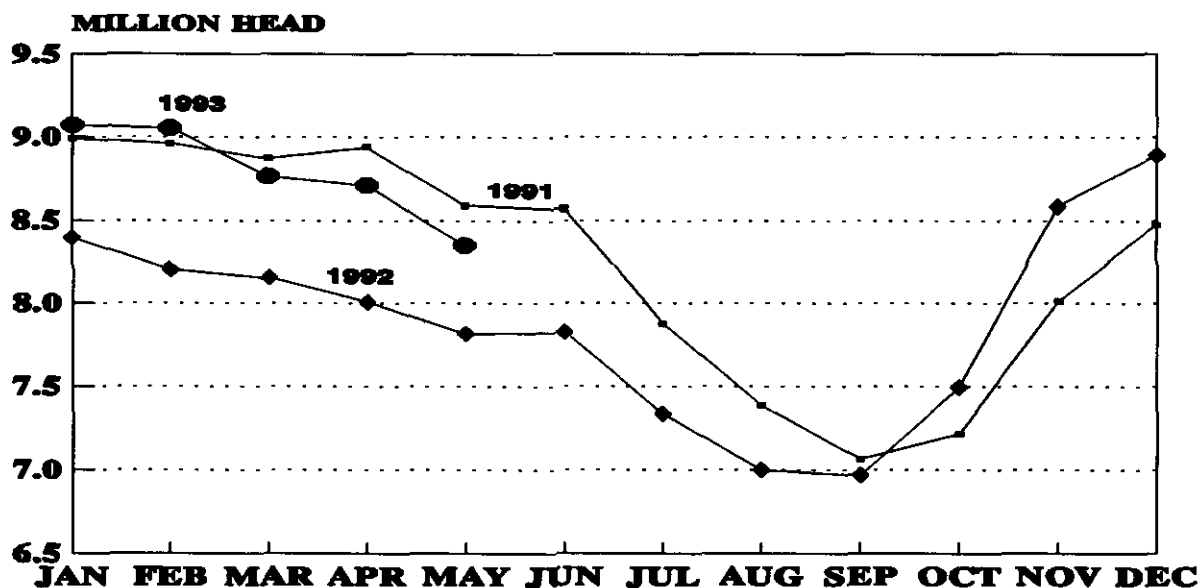
Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.35 million head, up 7 percent from a year ago but down 3 percent from May 1, 1991.

Placements of cattle and calves on feed in the 7 States during April totaled 1.32 million, down 8 percent from both last year and two years ago. These are the lowest April placements since 1980. Net placements of 1.19 million for April were also down 8 percent from last year and two years ago.

Marketings of fed cattle during April totaled 1.55 million, up 4 percent from last year but down 6 percent from two years ago.

Other disappearance totaled 126,000 head compared to 125,000 in April 1992 and 128,000 in April 1991.
