Cattle on Feed Up 2 Percent in 7 Monthly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 8.91 million head, up 2 percent from a year ago and up 9 percent from March 1, 1992. This is the largest March inventory for the 7 States since 1974.

Placements in feedlots during February totaled 1.35 million, 7 percent above 1993 but 10 percent below 1992. Net placements of 1.27 million for February were up 10 percent from last year but 7 percent below 1992.

Marketings during February totaled 1.50 million, up 4 percent from a year ago and 6 percent above 1992.

Other disappearance during February was 76,000 head, 31 percent below last year and 37 percent below 1992.

Cattle on Feed in 1000+ Capacity Feedlots Up 4 percent

Cattle and calves on feed March 1, 1994, for the 7 States in the feedlots with 1,000 or more head capacity totaled 7.81 million head, 4 percent above the previous year. The inventory in the 1,000+ capacity feedlots accounted for 87.7 percent of the total inventory.

Historic estimates for 1,000+ capacity feedlots are included as a separate report starting on page H-1.

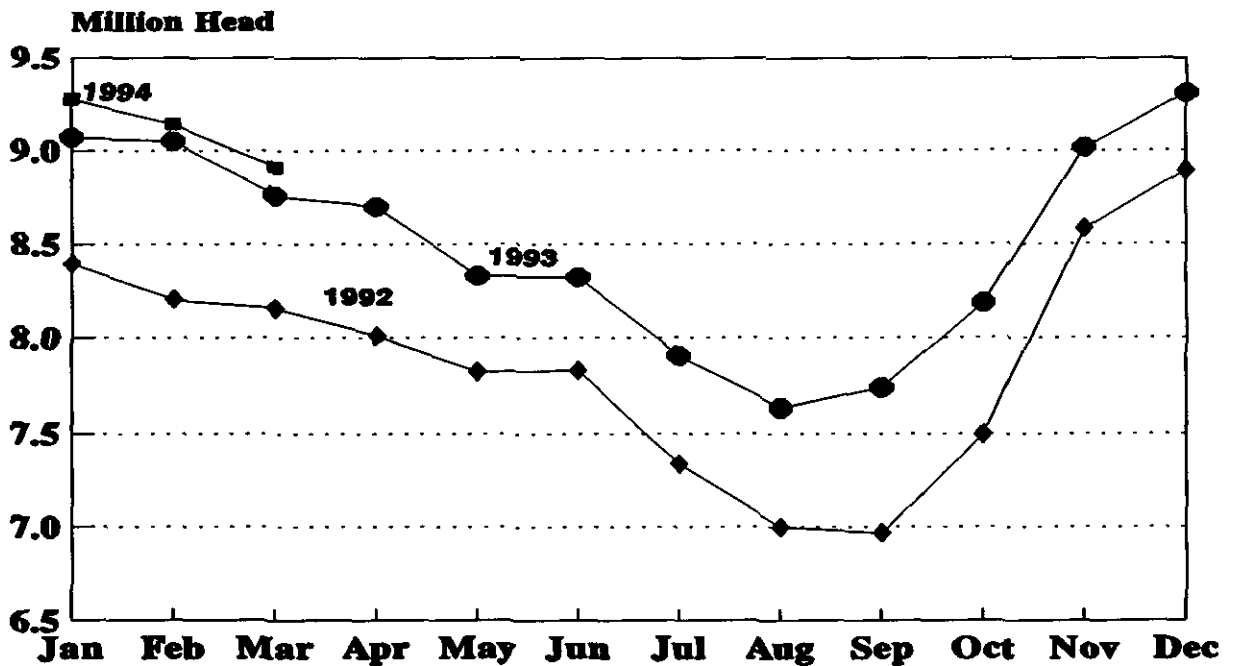
