## Cattle on Feed Down 3 Percent in 7 Monthly States

**Cattle and calves on feed** for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.37 million head, down 3 percent from a year ago but up 5 percent from August 1, 1992.

**Placements** in feedlots during July totaled 1.53 million, 2 percent above 1993 and 7 percent above 1992. Net placements of 1.47 million for July were up 4 percent from last year and 9 percent above 1992.

**Marketings** during July totaled 1.65 million, down 2 percent from both 1993 and 1992. These are the lowest July marketings since 1984.

**Other disappearance** during July was 55,000 head, 32 percent below last year and 35 percent below 1992.

## Cattle on Feed in 1000+ Capacity Feedlots Up Fractionally

**Cattle and calves on feed** August 1, 1994, for the 7 States in the feedlots with 1,000 or more head capacity totaled 6.69 million head, fractionally above the previous year and 9 percent above 1992. The inventory in the 1,000+ capacity feedlots accounted for 90.8 percent of the total inventory.

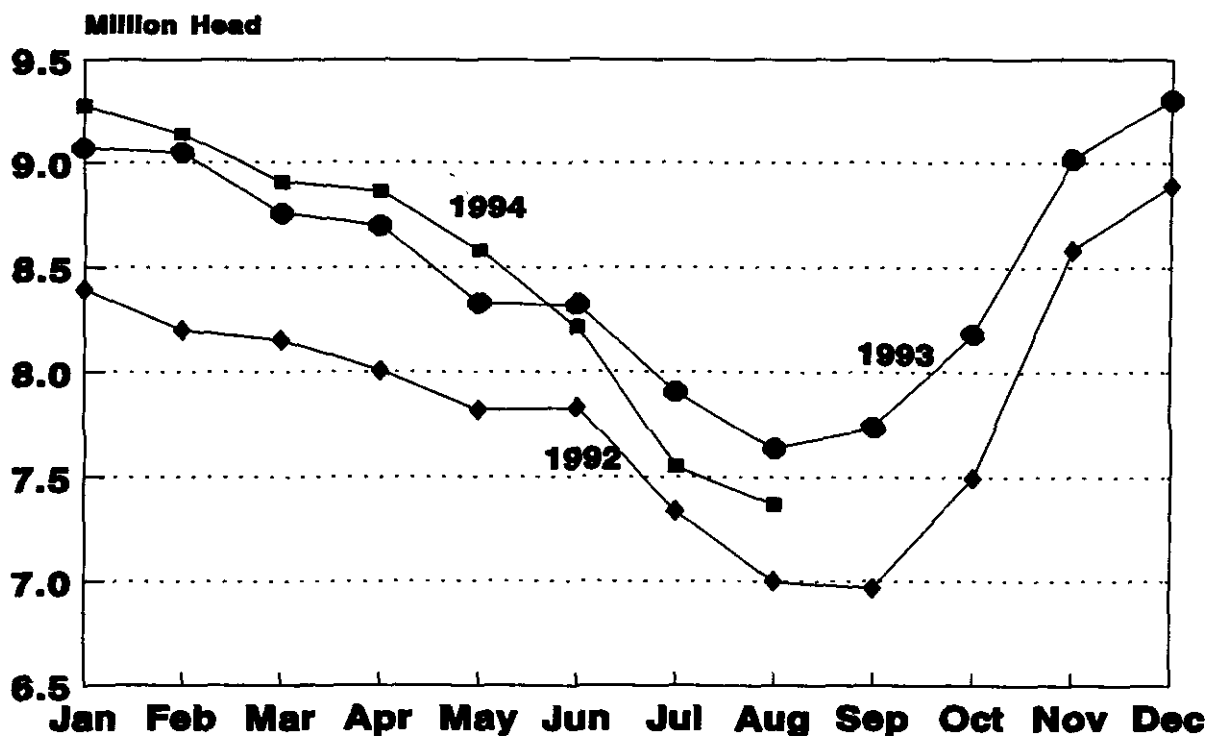

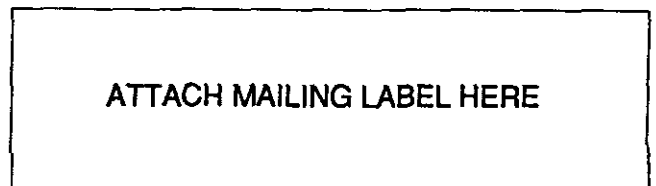

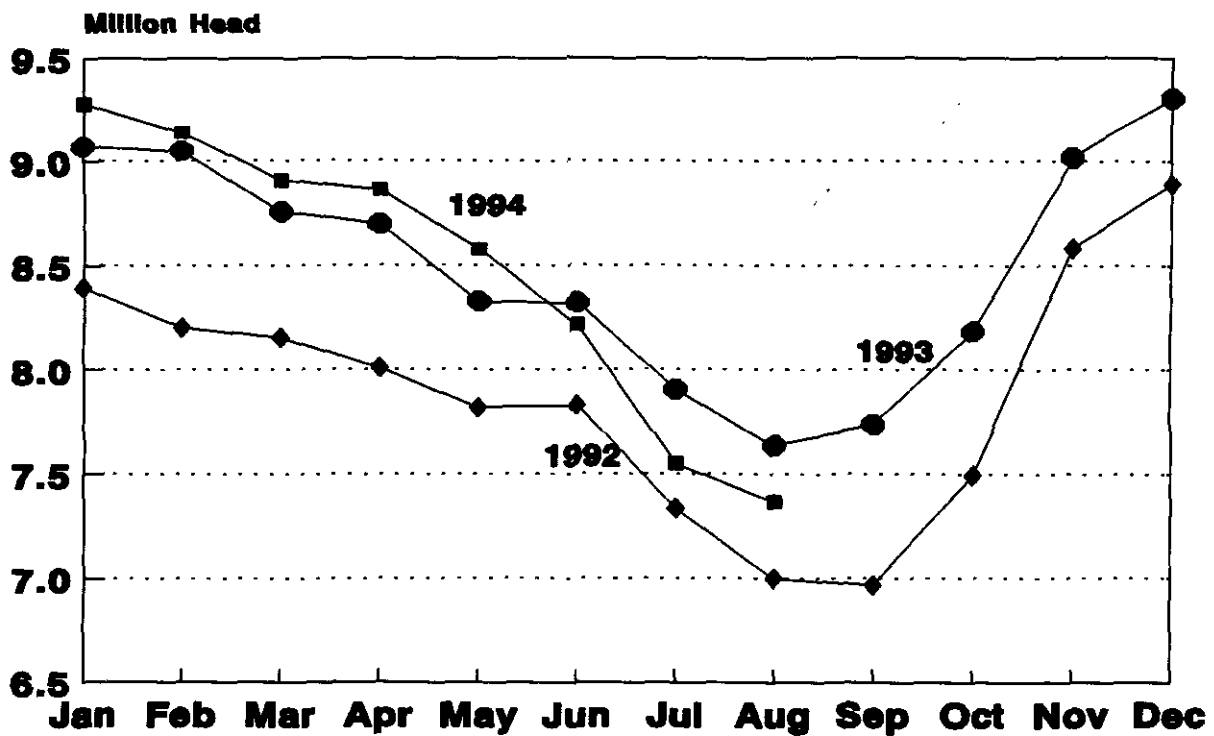
