

Cattle on Feed



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Released September 16, 1994, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Inventory estimates refer to September 1, 1994. Placement and marketing estimates refer to the month of August.

Cattle on Feed Down 5 Percent in 7 Monthly States

Cattle and calves on feed for slaughter market in the 7 States preparing monthly estimates totaled 7.38 million head, down 5 percent from a year ago but up 6 percent from September 1, 1992.

Placements in feedlots during August totaled 1.79 million, 4 percent below 1993 but 9 percent above 1992. Net placements of 1.74 million for August were down 3 percent from last year but 11 percent above 1992.

Marketings during August totaled 1.73 million, up 3 percent from 1993 and up 9 percent from 1992.

Other disappearance during August was 56,000 head, 27 percent below last year and 31 percent below 1992.

Cattle on Feed in 1000+ Capacity Feedlots Down 1 Percent

Cattle and calves on feed August 1, 1994, for the 7 States in the feedlots with 1,000 or more head capacity totaled 6.78 million head, down 1 percent from last year but 11 percent above 1992. The inventory in the 1,000+ capacity feedlots accounted for 92.0 percent of the total inventory.

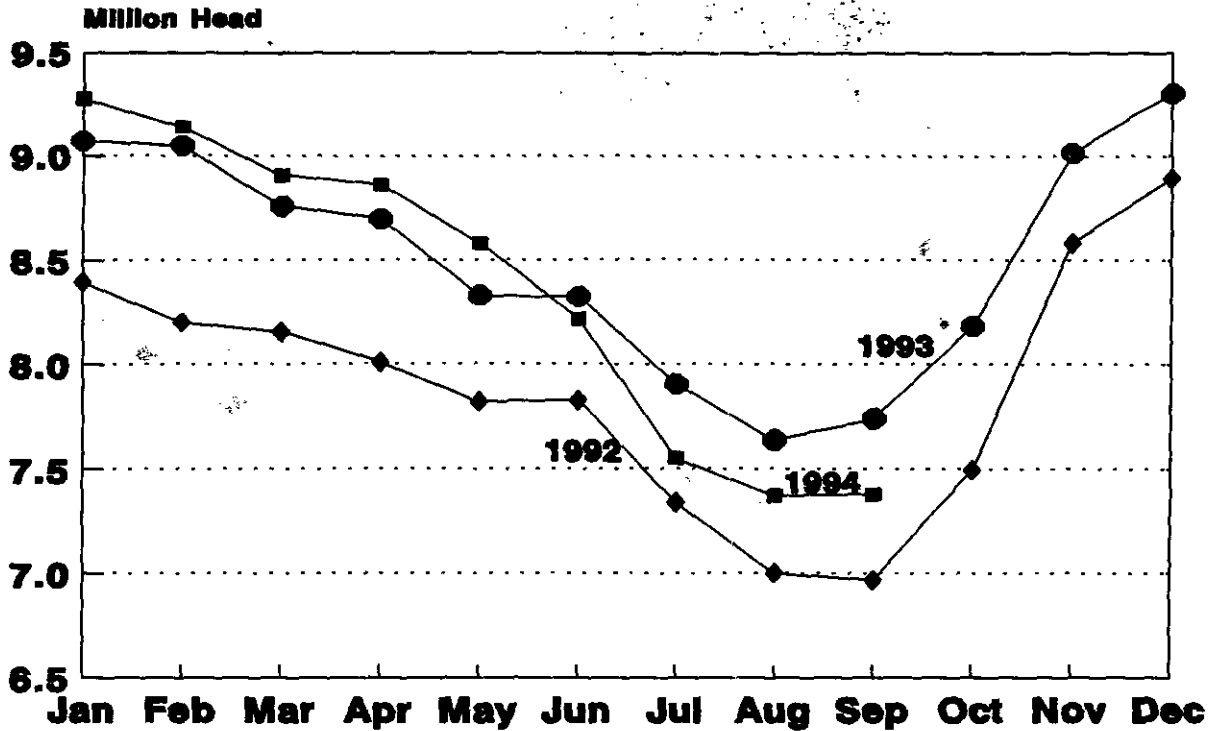
