THIS IS MADE NECESSARY BECAUSE OF AN ERROR IN REPORTING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE BY A LARGE STORAGE WAREHOUSE. THE FIGURE ON DRESSED FOWL WHICH WAS RELEASED ON Oct. 13TH AS OF Oct. 1 SHOULD BE CHANGED FROM 4,316 TO 3,931. HOLDINGS DRESSED POULTRY ON OCTOBER 1 WERE AS FOLLOWS: BROILERS 11,028, ROASTERS 8,993, FOWL 3,931, TURKEYS 5,712, MISCELLANEOUS 14,683, TOTAL 44,347. ALL FIGURES WITH THREE ZEROS OMITTED.
