REVISION OF 26 CITIES STORAGE FIGURES

THE FOLLOWING REVISIONS OF FIGURES RELEASED ON THE 26 CITIES WEEKLY STORAGE REPORT ARE MADE AS A RESULT OF THE ADDITION OF CERTAIN NEW WAREHOUSES WHICH FIRST BEGAN OPERATIONS DURING THE PRESENT STORING SEASON, AND WHOSE HOLDINGS WERE FIRST INCLUDED IN THE RELEASE OF MONDAY, JULY 26. THESE REVISIONS ARE MADE TO SHOW THE EARLIER SEASONS MOVEMENT AS AFFECTED BY THESE WAREHOUSES. SINCE THE WEEKLY REPORT IS ISSUED EACH MONDAY AS OF THE PREVIOUS SATURDAY MORNING, NO FIGURES ARE AVAILABLE FOR JUNE 1 NOR JULY 1 WHICH FELL ON OTHER DAYS OF THE WEEK. THE DATES TO WHICH THE REVISIONS APPLY ARE THOSE NEAREST TO JUNE 1 AND JULY 1, AND THEREFORE PERMIT A CLOSE COMPARISON OF THE 26 CITIES HOLDINGS AND THE TOTAL U.S. HOLDINGS ON THESE DATES.
