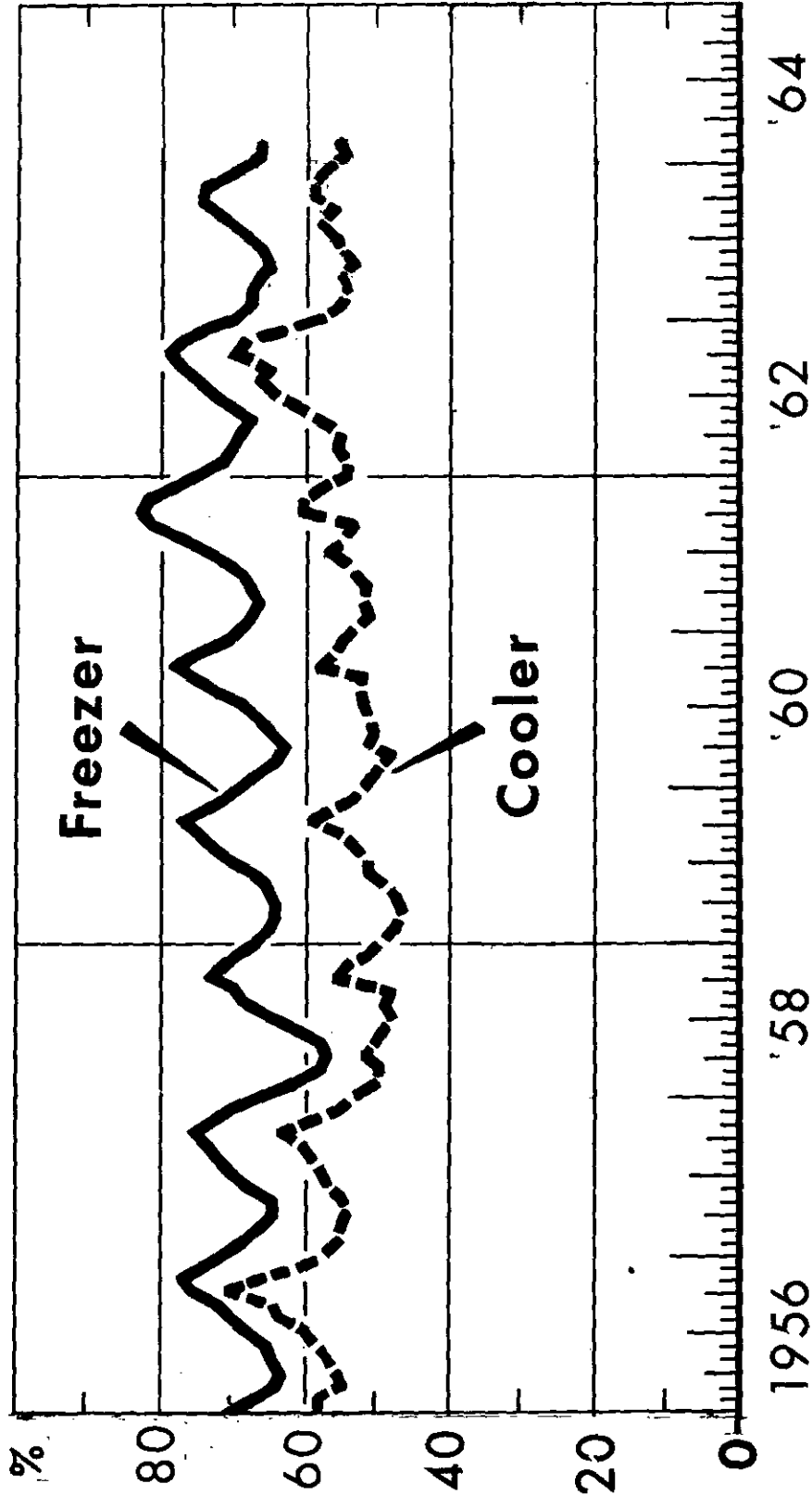

## COLD STORAGE REPORT, APRIL 1, 1964

### Commodity Summary

Refrigerated warehouse stocks totaled 5.4 billion pounds on April 1, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Although slightly lower than stocks on April 1, 1963, they were 21 percent larger than the 1958-62 average. April 1 cooler stocks totaled 2.2 billion pounds, a record for this time of year. The 3.4 billion pounds of product in freezer rooms were the third largest of record for April 1. Warehouse stocks of orange concentrate increased during March in contrast to the average decline for the month. The unexpected gain raised total warehouse supplies to 29 million gallons on April 1 compared with 47 million stored on this date last year. Average April 1 stocks are 32 million gallons. Frozen vegetables in storage on April 1 were down 65 million pounds to 1,050 million. Holdings were lowered during March in all sections of the country except the West South Central when a 5 percent gain in stocks occurred. All frozen vegetable items except broccoli, mixed vegetables, french fries, and spinach were reduced thus bringing the April 1 inventory down 1 percent from last year's supply but 42 percent above average.

Butter stocks, reduced by 3 million pounds during March totaled 188 million on April 1. This time last year, 345 million pounds were in storage. American cheese supplies also were down 3 million pounds from March 1 and totaled 261 million on April 1. Holdings of shell eggs amounted to 34 thousand cases on April 1, a drop of 44 thousand from a month earlier. This supply was two-thirds of the stock held on April 1, 1963 and about one-third of average. Frozen egg stocks moved up slightly during the month. A 4-million pound gain brought warehouse supplies to 44 million pounds, 6 million more than a year earlier but 14 million less than average. Poultry supplies were down sharply from March 1 following a 54-million pound reduction. Supplies of 265 million pounds compared with 251 million held at this time last year and 241 million, the average for April 1. Holdings of turkeys amounted to 149 million pounds, a drop of 39 million from the previous month. Total red meat supplies rose 20 million pounds to 794 million. This was 25 percent greater than supplies of a year earlier and 51 percent greater than average.

### Cooler and freezer stock changes

Cooler-held stocks declined to 2.2 billion pounds on April 1, the result of March withdrawals in holdings of fresh vegetables, fresh fruits, cheese, eggs, canned milk, and cured beef and pork. These declines more than offset gains in stocks of dried and evaporated fruits, nuts in shell and shelled, and canned meats, which resulted in an overall reduction of 359 million pounds. Freezer stocks declined 152 million pounds to 3.4 billion on April 1. A year earlier, stocks totaled 3.6 billion pounds. During March, there was a build-up in stocks of cream, eggs, juices, and pork. However, butter, poultry, fruits, vegetables, beef, veal, lamb, and mutton showed a net decrease during the month.

### Storage occupancy in public warehouses

Cooler occupancy was 56 percent of capacity on April 1, an increase of 2 points from March 1. Occupancy of cooler space was 6 points greater than the 1958-62 average for this time of year and 2 points above April 1 a year ago. Freezer occupancy was 66 percent of capacity, unchanged from last month but 2 points greater than average for April 1 and 1 point below last year.

### Poultry and poultry products

Frozen poultry supplies on April 1 were 265 million pounds 6 percent more than a year earlier and 10 percent above average. Holdings of frozen poultry decreased 54 million pounds during March, compared with a reduction of 39 million during March 1963. The average decline is 42 million pounds. Turkey stocks were 149 million pounds on April 1 -- a drop of 39 million during March. The inventory was 12 percent above average but 3 percent below April 1 a year earlier and 22

percent less than the record April 1 stocks in 1962. Frozen egg supplies were 44 million pounds -- an increase of 4 million pounds from March 1. A year earlier stocks were 38 million pounds and the average for the date is 58 million. Stocks of shell eggs were 34 thousand cases on April 1, compared with 51 thousand on that date last year and the April 1 average of 95 thousand cases.

#### Dairy and dairy products

Cold storage stocks of butter on April 1 were 188 million pounds, 46 percent less than a year earlier but 48 percent more than average for April 1. Holdings declined 3 million pounds during March, compared with a 170 million increase in March 1963 and the average increase of 20 million. Government owned butter in storage on April 1 was reported at 151 million pounds, leaving 37 million pounds in commercial channels, compared with 31 million a year earlier. Holdings of American cheese on April 1 were 261 million pounds, 16 percent less than a year earlier and 9 percent below average for the date. Stocks declined 3 million pounds during March compared with a 16-million pound reduction a year earlier and the 4-million pound average March decline.

#### Juices, vegetables, and fruits

Orange concentrate stocks usually are lower on April 1 than on March 1 but this year a 400 thousand gallon increase raised warehouse stocks to 29 million gallons. The gain was primarily in the producing South Atlantic region but a small gain also was reported in the East North Central storage area. Stocks were still about 38 percent under the inventory on April 1, 1963 and 10 percent under average for the date. April 1 stocks of frozen vegetables throughout the country generally were lower than a month earlier. A drop of 65 million pounds brought the warehouse inventory to 1,050 million pounds, compared with 1,064 million stored on this date last year. The average for April 1 is 740 million pounds. Stocks of broccoli, mixed vegetables, french fries, and spinach increased notably in the West Coast States and countered withdrawals in other regions to raise total warehouse stocks above a year ago. Supplies of frozen fruit were down to 294 million pounds after a March disappearance of 46 million pounds. Stocks for this time of year were 23 percent smaller than last year and 18 percent less than average. The largest reduction was 16 million pounds of strawberries which on April 1, totaled 77 million pounds. Of this amount, approximately 44 percent were in retail containers compared with 39 percent on April 1, 1963.

#### Meat and meat products

Supplies of meat and meat products increased 21 million pounds during March to 794 million on April 1. A year ago stocks gained 80 million pounds and the average change is an increase of 10 million pounds. Holdings were 25 percent more than on April 1, 1963 and 51 percent above average. Beef holdings were 268 million pounds, about the same as a month earlier. The April 1 inventory was 41 percent above the same date last year and 76 percent more than average. Frozen beef holdings were 253 million pounds, the largest April 1 holdings since 1944. Total stocks of pork were 20 percent above a year earlier and 40 percent above average. Frozen pork holdings increased 19 million pounds during March to 362 million. Cooler pork totaled 36 million pounds, a decline of 3 million pounds during the month. Supplies of frozen pork bellies on April 1 were 140 million pounds, compared with 114 million on March 1 and 103 million at this time last year.

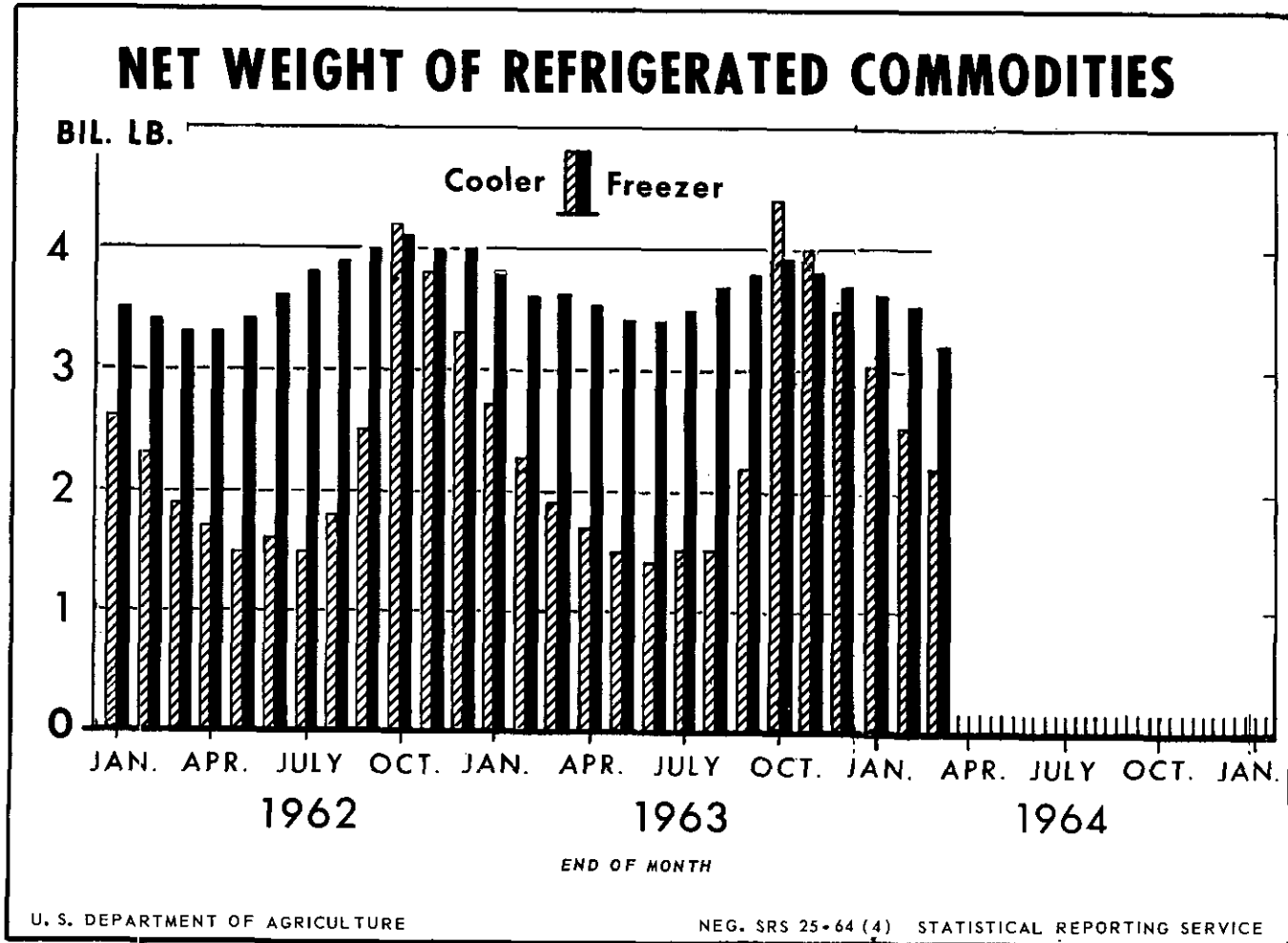

Butter: Decreased by 3 million pounds; March 1963 change was an increase of 17 million pounds; average March change is an increase of 20 million pounds.

Cheese: Decreased by 16 million pounds; March 1963 decrease was 17 million pounds; average March decrease is 6 million pounds.

Shell eggs: Decreased by 44,000 cases; March 1963 change was an increase of 22,000 cases; average March change is a decrease of 23,000 cases.

Frozen eggs: Increased by 4 million pounds; March 1963 increase was .02 million pounds; average March increase is 4 million pounds.

Frozen poultry: Decreased by 54 million pounds; March 1963 decrease was 39 million pounds; average March decrease was 42 million pounds.
