COLD STORAGE REPORT, JULY 1, 1967

Commodity Summary

July 1 stocks in refrigerated warehouses were 5.9 billion pounds, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Cooler-held stocks totaled 1.6 billion and freezer holdings were 4.3 billion pounds. A year earlier, total refrigerated stocks were 4.8 billion and the 1961-65 average is 4.9 billion pounds.

Orange concentrate in storage was at an all-time high-87 million gallons. Stocks totaled 54 million on July 1, 1966 and the average is 51 million gallons. The June net gain of 18 million gallons compared with a 2-million gallon rise during June 1966 and an average decline of 700 thousand gallons during June.

Frozen fruit stocks moved up to 394 million pounds after a seasonal rise of 72 million pounds. Stocks were lower than a year earlier but above average for the date. Warehouse stocks of frozen vegetables declined 81 million pounds during June to 1,210 million pounds on July 1. Supplies were 17 percent larger than year earlier holdings and 38 percent above average.

Butter in storage increased to 194 million pounds, up 42 million from June 1. This gain was 9 million more than a year earlier but 2 million below average. Butter stocks were more than double the July 1, 1966 holdings but one-third less than average.

American cheese stocks moved up 23 million pounds to 378 million on July 1. Year earlier holdings were 321 million pounds and the average is 380 million pounds.

Shell egg holdings totaled 423 thousand cases on July 1 and frozen eggs totaled 83 million pounds. Stocks of both commodities were larger than a year earlier, but frozen eggs were below average for the date.

Holdings of meat were 652 million pounds, 73 million less than on June 1. On July 1, 1966, stocks totaled 518 million pounds and the average is 590 million pounds. Holdings of beef were down to 266 million pounds after a June reduction of 22 million pounds. A 45-million pound decline in pork brought July 1 stocks down to 291 million pounds.

Space Occupancy in Public Warehouses

Utilization of freezer space increased 1 point during June and on July 1 was 71 percent. Occupancy was lower in the New England and Mountain regions but unchanged or higher elsewhere. Occupancy was 59 percent a year earlier and average is 66 percent.

July 1 occupancy of cooler rooms at 59 percent was unchanged from a month earlier but 9 points above a year earlier. The average is 56 percent.

Fruits, Vegetables, and Juices

Orange concentrate stocks were a record high on July 1 at 87 million gallons. Holdings were up 18 million gallons from June 1 compared with a 2 million gain a year earlier. The average June change is a decline of 700 thousand gallons.

Frozen fruit stocks totaled 394 million pounds, up 72 million from a month earlier. Holdings were 37 million pounds less than on July 1, 1966 but 51 million more than average.

Frozen vegetables in storage on July 1 were 1,210 million pounds after an 81-million pound June decrease. Stocks were 179 million more than a year earlier and 333 million above average. The 81-million pound June decrease compared with 60 million last year and the average decline of 7 million.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks on July 1, were 306 million pounds, 10 million pounds more than a month earlier and 146 million more than a year earlier. Average July 1 holdings are 193 million pounds. Turkeys, whole birds, totaled 122 million pounds on July 1 compared with 113 million on June 1. Turkey parts amounted to 37 million pounds, about the same as a month earlier.

Total turkey holdings were more than double July 1, 1966 stocks and two-thirds more than average.

Stocks of shell eggs advanced to 423 thousand cases following a June gain of 158 thousand. On July 1 last year, stocks were 101 thousand cases after a 25-thousand June gain. Average July 1 stocks are 352 thousand and the average June gain is 102 thousand cases.

Frozen eggs stored on July 1 were up 12 million pounds from June 1 and totaled 83 million pounds. These holdings were 50 percent larger than a year earlier but 20 percent below average.

Dairy Products

July 1 stocks of butter totaled 194 million pounds-42 million more than a month earlier and more than double holdings of a year earlier. Average holdings for the date are 298 million pounds. Government-owned stocks accounted for 138 million pounds of the July 1 inventory.

American cheese holdings increased 23 million pounds during June and on July 1 totaled 378 million. Average holdings are 380 million. Government-owned stocks were 11 million.

Meat Products

July 1 stocks of meat totaled 652 million pounds compared with 725 million a month earlier and the average of 590 million. Warehouse holdings declined 73 million pounds in June--20 million pounds more than the year-earlier decline and 14 million more than average.

Total pork in storage of 291 million pounds on July 1 was more than one-third larger than a year earlier but 2 percent less than average.

Stocks of beef totaled 266 million pounds on July 1 following a June decrease of 22 million pounds. A year earlier, beef in storage increased 6 million pounds during June and the average June change is a 6 million pound decrease. There were 212 million pounds in storage at this time in 1966 and average stocks are 185 million.

Special Butterfat-Sugar Mix Survey

A special survey was made of the amount of butterfat-sugar mix in storage as of July 1, 1967. A total of 62,617,000 pounds was reported. Of these stocks, 56 percent were in Middle Atlantic warehouses; 19 percent in the South Atlantic; 7 percent in each of the East and West North Central regions; and 11 percent in other regions.

This was a single time survey and will not be made each month. However, stocks of this product are included in the miscellaneous freezer category each month.

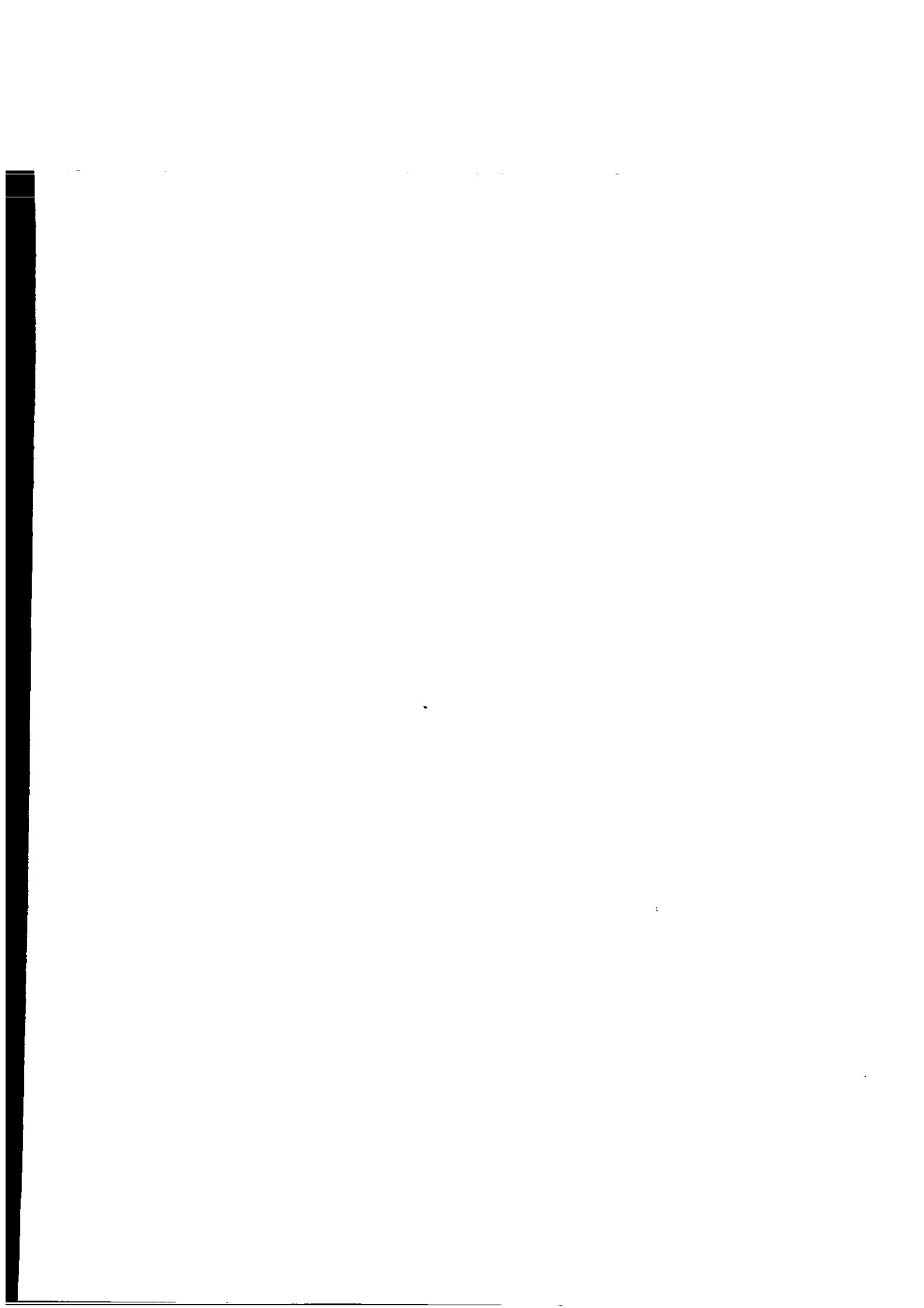
