COLD STORAGE REPORT AUGUST 1, 1968

Changes During Past Month

Cold storage stocks of butter, cheese, frozen eggs, turkeys, beef, strawberries and peas increased during July according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of shell eggs, orange juice, pork and french fries declined.

Butter holdings were up 25 million pounds with American cheese 17 million higher. Frozen eggs stocks increased 4 million pounds during July. Turkeys were up 38 million pounds while frozen beef increased 11 million. Frozen peas increased 147 million pounds and strawberries were up 15 million.

Stocks of shell eggs decreased 29 thousand cases. Orange juice stocks dropped 42 million pounds and stocks of french fries were off 116 million. Total pork was 82 million pounds below last month. All pork items were down with bellies accounting for 44 million pounds of the decline.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms were 61 percent occupied on August 1, one point below last month but 1 point above a year earlier and 5 points above average. Occupancy was above last month in the East North Central, Mountain and Pacific Regions but lower in the West North Central, South Atlantic and East South Central. Occupancy of cooler rooms was unchanged in the other regions. Freezer room occupancy on August 1 was 67 percent, up 1 point from July 1, the same as average but 7 points below a year earlier. Utilization compared with a month earlier was the same in the North Central regions, lower in the South Atlantic, South Central and Mountain regions and above in the other regions.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks decreased by 9.5 million pounds during July and on August 1 totaled 1,442 million pounds. This is 6 percent below a year earlier. Some of the more significant reductions from a month earlier were recorded for apples, nutmeats, and shell eggs. Partially offsetting were increases in butter, other fresh fruits, and American cheese.

Stocks in freezerrooms totaled 4,005 million pounds on August 1, down 32 million from July 1. The August 1, 1967 freezer stocks totaled 4,444 million pounds. Decreases in french fried potatoes, frozen pork, and orange juice helped to offset increases in frozen poultry, fruit, and green pea stocks.

Meat Products

Stocks of meat totaled 543 million pounds, 72 million less than a month earlier. This compares with year-earlier stocks of 601 million pounds and average stocks of 537 million. Pork holdings decreased 82 million pounds during July to 244 million. Frozen pork bellies at 58 million pounds decreased 43 percent during July compared with a 32 percent decrease during the same month a year earlier. All other pork items shared in the decrease in pork holdings during July. Beef stocks totaled 210 million pounds on August 1 compared with month-earlier holdings of 199 million and year-earlier holdings of 265 million.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks increased 35 million pounds during July to 331 million pounds. This was 10 percent below a year earlier and 63 percent above average. Turkey holdings were 223 million pounds compared with 185 million last month, and a 5-year average of 104 million. Whole turkeys totaled 195 million pounds, while parts, cut ups, and further processing items totaled 28 million.

Shell eggs in storage were down to 258 thousand cases from 287 thousand on July 1. July 1 stocks were 133 thousand cases below year-earlier holdings and 15 thousand cases below average. Frozen egg holdings were 112 million pounds, up 4 million from July 1. Year-earlier stocks totaled 93 million.

Dairy Products

Supplies of creamery butter in refrigerated storage totaled 250 million pounds on August 1 compared with 228 million a year earlier and average stocks of 283 million pounds. The July gain was 25 million pounds below the 37-million pound gain a year earlier and the average gain of 12 million. Government-owned butter on August 1 totaled 185 million pounds, up 14 million from a month earlier.

American cheese holdings were 387 million pounds, down 13 million from a year earlier but 2 million above average. The July increase of 17 million pounds was above the 15-million pound gain a year earlier but below the average gain of 21 million.

Fruits, Juices, and Vegetables

Holdings of orange concentrate were 49 million gallons, 4 million below a month earlier. The holdings were down 40 percent from a year earlier but 3 percent above average.

Frozen fruit totaled 501 million pounds on August 1, compared with 409 million a month earlier and 508 million a year earlier. Strawberry holdings increased to 205 million pounds, 5 percent below a year earlier but 4 percent above average. Holdings of all other frozen fruits except apples and grapes also increased during July.

Fresh apple holdings declined to 9 million pounds on August 1 compared with 35 million a month earlier and 25 million a year earlier.

Frozen vegetable stocks increased 29 million pounds during July to 1,356 million pounds. This was 7 percent above August 1 a year earlier and 40 percent above average. Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 1,087 million pounds, 15 percent above a month earlier. Year-earlier stocks totaled 960 million pounds.

Increases during July in inventories of beans and green peas more than offset lower stocks of other vegetable items. French fries totaled 269 million pounds, 116 million less than on July 1. Year-earlier stocks totaled 306 million pounds.
