Five-Year Averages to Be Discontinued:

"Effective January 1, 1969, the Statistical Reporting Service plans to discontinue calculation and publication of 5-year averages that appear in this report. The report will contain data for the current and the two preceding years. It is believed that changes in agriculture have decreased the value of the five-year averages for making comparisons."

New Release Time:

Beginning with the January 16, 1969 Report, all Cold Storage releases will be released at 3 P.M. (ET) instead of 2:00 P.M. as in the past.

Refrigerated Warehouse Report to be Released:

The biennial report on "Capacity of Refrigerated Warehouses in the United States" will be released December 20, 1968 at 3:00 P.M. EST.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semiprivate warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed services are not reported. November 30, 1968 data are preliminary.)

COLD STORAGE REPORT, DECEMBER 1, 1968

Changes During Past Month

Cold storage stocks of fresh apples, pears, grapes, cream, butter, eggs, turkeys, and orange juice decreased in November 1968 but stocks of onions, nuts, frozen apples, carrots, french fried potatoes, pork bellies, and beef increased according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Holdings for fresh apples were down 300 million pounds, grapes 35 million, butter 26 million, turkeys 106 million, orange juice 59 million, and frozen eggs 10 million pounds. Shell eggs were down 84 thousand cases.

Stocks of onions increased 3 million pounds during the month, frozen apples 32 million, carrots 25 million, french fried potatoes 70 million, frozen beef 23 million and pork bellies 13 million.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on December 1 were 64 percent occupied, 4 points below last month but 2 points above a year earlier. Percent occupancy was below last month in all regions except the Middle Atlantic which was unchanged.

Freezer room occupancy on December 1 was 74 percent, down 2 points from last month and 5 points below a year earlier. Percent occupancy in the New England and Mountain regions was the same as last month but other regions were lower.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks totaled 3,617 million pounds, a decrease of 299 million during November, but 8 million above a year earlier. Stocks in freezer rooms totaled 4,688 million pounds on December 1, down 137 million from November 1 and 216 million from a year earlier.

Meat Products

Stocks of meat totaled 604 million pounds, 32 million more than a month earlier, but 34 million below a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies at 33 million pounds increased 13 million during November but were 16 million less than a year earlier. Hams, at 30 million pounds, declined 12 million during the month. Beef stocks totaled 290 million pounds, 24 million above a month earlier and 21 million more than a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks declined 108 million pounds in November to 499 million and 107 million below a year earlier. Turkey holdings were 398 million pounds, down 106 million from last month and 31 million below a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 369 million pounds. Parts, cut up, and further processed items totaled 29 million.

Shell eggs declined 84 thousand cases in November to 88 thousand. December 1 stocks were 62 thousand cases below year earlier holdings. Frozen egg holdings were 82 million pounds, down 13 million from a year earlier and 10 million below November 1.

Dairy Products

Supplies of creamery butter in refrigerated storage totaled 136 million pounds, 26 million below a month earlier and 49 million below a year earlier. Government-owned butter on December 1 totaled 120 million pounds, down 22 million from a month earlier.

American cheese holdings were 335 million pounds, 20 million below a year earlier. Stocks were down 12 million from a month earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate were 17 million gallons, 6 million below a month earlier. Holdings were down 20 million gallons from a year earlier.

Frozen fruit totaled 607 million pounds, 5 million less than a month earlier but 62 million above a year earlier. The largest declines in November were recorded for strawberries, cherries, "other frozen fruits," and blackberries. Largest gain in frozen fruit holdings was for apples.

Stocks of fresh apples were 2,001 million pounds--300 million less than a month earlier but 5 million above a year earlier.

Frozen vegetable stocks increased 30 million pounds during November to 1,970 million. This was 137 million above a year earlier.

The most significant increases in stocks during November were recorded for french fried potatoes, carrots, brussels sprouts, and "other frozen vegetables." The most significant declines were recorded for peas, corn, and regular cut snap beans. French fries totaled 376 million pounds, 70 million more than on November 1 and 8 million above a year earlier. Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 1,594 million pounds. Stocks were 40 million less than a month earlier but 129 million above a year earlier.
