

COLD STORAGE REPORT, FEBRUARY 1, 1969

Changes During Past Month

Cold storage stocks of fresh apples, grapes, butter, cheese, eggs, turkeys, strawberries, corn, green peas, and beef decreased during January but stocks of nuts, frozen apples, orange juice, and french fried potatoes increased, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Holdings of fresh apples were down 384 million pounds, grapes 32 million, butter 13 million, and American cheese 24 million. Shell eggs were down 4 thousand cases, and frozen eggs were down 11 million pounds. Turkey stocks declined 25 million pounds, strawberries 16 million, corn 31 million, green peas 40 million, and beef 15 million pounds.

Stocks of peanut nutmeats increased 20 million pounds and other nutmeats 9 million. Peanuts in shell increased 3 million pounds while other nuts in shell increased 14 million. Frozen apple stocks were up 12 million pounds, french fried potatoes 33 million pounds, and orange juice up 6 million gallons.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks totaled 2,655 million pounds, a decrease of 441 million during January and 10 million below a year earlier. Stocks in freezer rooms totaled 4,318 million pounds on February 1, down 191 million from January 1 and 212 million below a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on February 1 were 61 percent occupied, 3 points below last month but 1 point above a year earlier. Occupied cooler space was greater than last month in the East South Central region, unchanged in the New England region and less in all other regions.

Freezer rooms on February 1 were 69 percent occupied, 4 points below last month and 5 points below a year earlier. Compared with last month the Mountain region was unchanged while all other regions were lower.

Meat Products

Stocks of meat totaled 605 million pounds, 20 million less than a month earlier and 47 million below a year ago. Beef stocks totaled 282 million pounds, 15 million below January 1 but 6 million more than a year ago. Frozen pork bellies, 47 million pounds, declined 2 million during January and were 19 million less than a year earlier. Hams, 25 million pounds, increased 8 million during the month.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, 390 million pounds, declined 27 million pounds in January, and were 135 million below a year earlier. Turkey holdings were 292 million pounds, down 25 million during last month and 69 million below a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 259 million pounds on February 1. Parts, cut up, and further processed items totaled 33 million.

Shell eggs, 55 thousand cases on February 1, declined 4 thousand in January and were 20 thousand cases below a year ago. Frozen egg holdings were 61 million pounds, down 11 million from January 1 and 25 million below a year ago.

Dairy Products

Supplies of creamery butter in refrigerated storage totaled 104 million pounds, 13 million below a month earlier and 59 million below a year ago. Government-owned butter on February 1 totaled 88 million pounds, down 15 million from January 1.

American cheese holdings were 294 million pounds, 24 million below a month earlier. Stocks were down 32 million from a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) were 25 million gallons, 6 million above a month earlier. Holdings were down 15 million gallons from a year earlier.

Frozen fruit totaled 513 million pounds, 36 million less than a month earlier but 24 million above a year earlier. The largest stock declines in January were recorded for "other frozen fruits" and strawberries. Frozen apple holdings increased during the month.

Stocks of fresh apples were 1,188 million pounds, 384 million less than a month earlier but 83 million above a year ago.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fried potatoes) totaled 1,345 million pounds. Stocks were 151 million less than a month earlier but 125 million above a year ago. The most significant declines in stocks during January were recorded for green peas, corn, green beans regular cut, and "other frozen vegetables".

French fried potato stocks totaled 429 million pounds, 33 million more than on January 1 and 22 million above a year earlier.
