

COLD STORAGE *Report*

May 1, 1969

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[Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semiprivate warehouses, apple houses, and meat-packing plants where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed services are not reported. April 30, 1969 data are preliminary.]

COLD STORAGE REPORT, May 1, 1969

Changes During Past Month

Cold storage stocks of turkeys, cherries, strawberries, corn, green peas, and fresh apples, grapes, and onions, decreased but stocks of butter, shell eggs, orange juice, french fried potatoes, hams and bellies increased during April, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Holdings of turkeys were down 46 million pounds, frozen cherries 11 million; strawberries, 13 million; corn, 26 million; and green peas 23 million pounds. Also down were fresh apples 236 million pounds; fresh grapes, 7 million; fresh onions, 11 million.

Stocks of butter increased 9 million pounds; shell eggs up sharply 100 thousand cases; and orange juice was up 4 million gallons. French fried potatoes increased 11 million pounds; hams, 18 million; and bellies, 21 million pounds.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks totaled 1,642 million pounds, a decrease of 267 million during April and 99 million below a year earlier. Stocks in freezers totaled 4,040 million pounds on May 1, down 16 million from April 1 and 90 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on May 1 were 61 percent occupied, 1 point above last month and 2 points above a year earlier. The percent occupied was above last month in the New England, East North Central, West North Central, South Atlantic and East South Central regions but was down in all other regions.

Freezer rooms on May 1, were 65 percent occupied, the same as last month but 3 points above a year earlier. The percent occupied was above last month in the New England, Middle Atlantic, East North Central, South Atlantic and West South Central regions, the same in the West North Central and Pacific regions and below in the East South Central and Mountain regions.

Meat Products

Stocks of meat on May 1, totaled 673 million pounds, 57 million more than a month earlier and 11 million above a year ago. Beef stocks totaled 263 million pounds, 11 million below April 1 but 48 million more than a year ago. Total pork holdings of 323 million on May 1 were 53 million above last month but 31 million below a year ago. Frozen pork bellies were 97 million pounds, up 21 million during April but 19 million less than a year earlier. Hams, at 34 million pounds increased 18 million during the month.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 238 million pounds, declined 49 million pounds in April, and were 112 million below a year earlier. Turkey holdings were 155 million pounds, down 46 million from last month and 70 million from a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 129 million pounds on May 1. Parts, cut-up, and further processed items totaled 26 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Supplies of creamery butter in cold storage totaled 131 million pounds, 9 million above a month earlier but 49 million below a year ago. Government-owned butter on May 1 totaled 106 million pounds, up 4 million from April 1.

American cheese holdings were 261 million pounds, 2 million below a month earlier and 54 million below a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 41 million gallons, 4 million above a month earlier, and 6 million above a year ago.

Frozen fruits totaled 390 million pounds, 52 million less than a month earlier but 47 million above a year ago. The largest declines in stocks during April were recorded for strawberries, cherries, and "other frozen fruits."

Stocks of fresh apples were 315 million pounds, 236 million less than a month earlier but 33 million more than a year ago.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fried potatoes) totaled 1,016 million pounds, 63 million less than a month earlier but 47 million above a year ago. The largest stock declines in April were recorded for corn and green peas. Stocks of spinach increased during the month.

French fried potato stocks totaled 524 million pounds, 11 million more than on April 1 and 37 million above a year earlier.
