

COLD STORAGE Report

June 1, 1969

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Changes During Past Month

Cold storage stocks of fresh apples, frozen fruits, french fried potatoes, turkeys, and beef decreased during May. Stocks of butter, cheese, eggs, and orange juice increased according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Holdings of fresh apples were down 178 million pounds, and total frozen fruits 40 million. Stocks also were down for french fried potatoes 23 million, turkeys 29 million, and frozen beef 21 million.

Stocks of butter increased 28 million pounds, American cheese 21 million, shell eggs 60 thousand cases, and concentrated orange juice 10 million gallons.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks totaled 1,424 million pounds, a decrease of 214 million during May and 136 million below a year earlier. Stocks in freezers totaled 3,977 million pounds on June 1, down 70 million from May 1 but 52 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on June 1 were 60 percent occupied, 1 point below last month but the same as a year earlier. The percent occupied was down in the Middle Atlantic, West South Central and Pacific Regions which more than offset increases in the New England, West North Central and South Atlantic Regions. The East North Central, East South Central and Mountain Regions remained unchanged.

Freezer rooms on June 1 were 64 percent occupied, 1 point below last month but 2 points below a year earlier. The percent occupied was below last month in all regions except in the South Atlantic, which was up and in the East North Central, which remained unchanged.

Meat Products

On June 1 beef stocks totaled 245 million pounds, 21 million below May 1 but 52 million more than a year ago. Total pork holdings at 300 million were 24 million below last month and 87 million below a year ago. Frozen pork

Beginning with the January 31, 1970 Cold Storage Report the following changes are to be made: Discontinue collecting and publishing data on individual stocks of celery and ducks. Plastic cream and cream (not including plastic) will be combined into total cream. Condensed milk, sweetened and unsweetened (bulk goods) and evaporated and condensed milk (case goods) will be combined into evaporated and condensed milk total.

Add a classification of pecans under nutmeats and nuts in shell. Frozen corn (cob and cut) will be separated into corn, cut and corn, cob.

Any reactions to these changes should be submitted to the Chairman, Crop Reporting Board no later than July 15, 1969.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semiprivate warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. Data are preliminary.)

bellies were 97 million pounds, up less than 1 million during May, but 33 million less than a year earlier. Hams at 29 million decreased 5 million during the month.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 209 million pounds, were down 29 million pounds in May and 102 million from a year earlier. Turkey holdings were 126 million pounds, down 29 million from last month and 68 million from a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 101 million pounds on June 1. Parts, cut-up, and further processed items totaled 25 million pounds.

Shell eggs totaled 233 thousand cases, up 60 thousand during May and 42 thousand cases above a year ago. Frozen egg holdings were 53 million pounds, up 4 million from May 1 but 42 million below a year ago.

Dairy Products

Creamery butter in cold storage totaled 162 million pounds, 28 million above a month earlier but 37 million below a year ago. Government-owned butter on June 1 totaled 133 million pounds, up 27 million from May 1.

American cheese holdings were 281 million pounds, 21 million above a month earlier, but 61 million below a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 51 million gallons, 10 million above a month earlier, and 5 million above a year ago.

Frozen fruits totaled 355 million pounds, 40 million less than a month earlier but 39 million above a year ago. The largest declines in stocks during May were recorded for apples, cherries, and "other frozen fruits."

Stocks of fresh apples were 136 million pounds, 178 million less than a month earlier but 25 million more than a year ago.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fried potatoes) totaled 930 million pounds, 85 million less than a month earlier but 37 million above a year ago. The largest stock declines in May were recorded for corn, green peas and green beans. Stocks of asparagus increased 9 million pounds during the month.

French fried potato stocks totaled 500 million pounds, 23 million less than on May 1 but 44 million above a year earlier.
