

# **COLD STORAGE** Report

July 1, 1969

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## Changes During Last Month

Cold storage stocks of creamery butter, cheese, eggs, orange juice, green peas, and strawberries increased during June. Stocks of apples, nuts, whole turkeys, french fried potatoes, beef and pork decreased according to the Crop Reporting Board.

Holdings of butter and American cheese each were up 34 million pounds, frozen eggs increased 7 million, green peas 86 million and strawberries 89 million. Shell eggs increased 57 thousand cases and orange juice 7 million gallons.

Stocks of apples decreased 93 million pounds, peanut meats 42 million, whole turkeys 5 million and french fried potatoes 60 million. Frozen beef stocks declined 16 million pounds and total frozen pork 50 million.

## Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks on July 1 totaled 1,328 million pounds, a decrease of 107 million during June and 124 million below a year earlier. Stocks in freezers totaled 4,057 million pounds on July 1, up 70 million from June 1 and 73 million above a year earlier.

## Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on July 1 were 61 percent occupied, unchanged from a month earlier, but 1 point below a year earlier. The percent occupied was down in the New England, South Atlantic, East South Central, West South Central, and Mountain Regions. Increases were recorded in all other regions.

Freezer rooms on July 1 were 63 percent occupied, unchanged from a month earlier, but 3 points below a year earlier. Increases in New England, West South Central, and Pacific Regions offset declines reported in all other regions except the South Atlantic which was unchanged.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. June 30, 1969 data are preliminary.)

### Meat Products

On July 1 beef stocks totaled 231 million pounds, 15 million below June 1 but 32 million more than a year ago. Total pork holdings at 248 million were 51 million below last month and 78 million below a year ago. Frozen pork bellies were 84 million pounds, down 12 million during June, and 19 million less than a year earlier. Hams at 17 million pounds decreased 12 million during the month.

### Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 200 million pounds, were down 7 million pounds in June and 96 million from a year earlier. Turkey holdings were 119 million pounds, down 4 million from a month earlier and 66 million from a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled nearly 93 million pounds on July 1. Parts, cut-up and further processed items totaled 27 million pounds.

Shell eggs totaled 294 thousand cases, up 57 thousand during June and 7 thousand cases above a year ago. Frozen egg holdings were 61 million pounds, up 7 million from June 1 but 47 million below a year ago.

### Dairy Products

Creamery butter in cold storage totaled 197 million pounds, 34 million above a month earlier but 28 million below a year ago. Government-owned butter on July 1 totaled 155 million pounds, up 24 million from June 1.

American cheese holdings were 315 million pounds, 34 million above a month earlier but 55 million less than a year ago.

### Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 58 million gallons, 7 million above a month earlier, and 9 million above a year ago.

Frozen fruits totaled 429 million pounds, 67 million more than a month earlier and 21 million above a year ago. The largest increase in frozen fruit stocks during June was recorded for strawberries.

Stocks of fresh apples were 43 million pounds, 93 million less than a month earlier but 8 million more than a year ago.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 964 million pounds, 23 million more than a month earlier and 25 million more than a year ago. The largest increase in frozen vegetable stocks during June was recorded for green peas.

French fried potato stocks totaled 441 million pounds, 60 million less than on June 1 but 71 million above a year earlier.
