Changes During September

Cold storage stocks increased during September for apples, pears, turkeys, corn, french fried potatoes, total beef and total pork. Stocks decreased for creamery butter, natural cheese, eggs, cherries, strawberries, orange juice, green peas and pork bellies.

Stocks of apples were up 1,203 million pounds during September, pears 4 million, turkeys 92 million, corn 158 million, french fried potatoes 18 million, total beef 44 million and total pork 7 million pounds.

Stocks of creamery butter declined 31 million pounds, natural cheese 19 million, shell eggs 35 thousand cases and frozen eggs 8 million pounds. Cherry stocks were down 16 million pounds, strawberries 9 million, orange juice 10 million gallons, green peas 27 million pounds and pork bellies 10 million pounds.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks on October 1 totaled 2,860 million pounds, up 1,333 million during September and 340 million above a year earlier. Stocks in freezers totaled 4,668 million pounds on October 1, up 241 million from September 1 and 106 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on October 1 were 61 percent occupied, compared with 63 percent a month earlier, and 62 percent a year earlier. Occupancy increased in the Middle Atlantic, South Atlantic, and East South Central Regions.

Freezer rooms on October 1 were 70 percent occupied, compared with 68 percent September 1 and 73 percent a year earlier. Occupancy increased regionally except in the West South Central, which was unchanged and the South Atlantic and East South Central regions, which were lower.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. September 30, 1969 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

October 1 beef stocks totaled 311 million pounds, 44 million above September 1 and 69 million more than a year ago. Total pork holdings at 176 million pounds were 7 million above last month but 21 million below a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 12 million pounds, 10 million less than on September 1, and 4 million less than a year ago. Hams at 24 million pounds increased 9 million during September but were 4 million less than a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks at 422 million pounds were up 98 million from September 1 but were 70 million pounds less than a year earlier. Turkey holdings at 329 million pounds were up 92 million from a month earlier but were 57 million less than a year ago. Whole turkeys totaled 297 million pounds on October 1. Parts, cut-ups, and further processed turkey items totaled 32 million pounds.

Dairy Products

Creamery butter in cold storage totaled 154 million pounds, 31 million less than a month earlier and 42 million less than a year earlier. Government-owned butter on October 1 totaled 121 million pounds, down 21 million from September 1.

American cheese holdings were 308 million pounds, down 19 million from the previous month and 68 million less than a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 38 million gallons, 10 million less than a month earlier but 9 million more than a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 611 million pounds, 1 million more than a month earlier and 30 million above a year earlier.

Stocks of fresh apples were 1,221 million pounds, 1,203 million above a month earlier and 313 million above a year earlier.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 1,565 million pounds, 224 million more than a month earlier and 8 million more than a year earlier. Corn had the largest increase in frozen vegetables stocks during September.

French fried potato stocks totaled 282 million pounds, 18 million more than on September 1 and 59 million above a year earlier.
