November 1, 1969

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Changes During October

Cold storage stocks increased during October for apples, grapes, turkeys, corn, french fried potatoes, total beef and total pork. Stocks decreased for butter, natural cheese, eggs, cherries, strawberries, orange juice, and green peas.

Stocks of fresh apples were up 1,867 million pounds during October, fresh grapes 122 million, turkeys 100 million, corn 23 million and french fried potatoes 60 million pounds. Total beef stocks increased 20 million pounds and total pork stocks 29 million pounds. Pork bellies increased 8 million pounds.

Stocks of butter declined 29 million pounds, natural cheese 20 million, shell eggs 43 thousand cases and frozen eggs 4 million pounds. Stocks of cherries were down 12 million pounds, strawberries 18 million, orange juice 6 million gallons and green peas 47 million pounds.

Cooler and Freezer Stock Changes

Cooler-held stocks on November 1 totaled 4,807 million pounds, up 1,974 million during October and 889 million above a year earlier. Stocks in freezers totaled 4,903 million pounds on November 1, up 206 million from October 1 and 127 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler rooms on November 1 were 65 percent occupied, 3 points above a month earlier, but 3 points below a year earlier. Cooler occupancy decreased during October in the New England, East North Central and Pacific regions, and was unchanged in the West North Central, South Atlantic and Mountain regions. The Middle Atlantic, East South Central and West South Central regions increased cooler occupancy.

Freezer rooms on November 1 were 74 percent occupied, 1 point above a month earlier, but 2 points below a year earlier. The freezer occupancy in the New England and South Atlantic regions was unchanged but increased in all other regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. October 31, 1969 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

November 1 beef stocks totaled 324 million pounds, 20 million above October 1 and 58 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings at 203 million pounds were 29 million above last month but 20 million below a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 20 million pounds, 8 million more than on October 1, but about the same as a year earlier. Hams at 39 million pounds increased 14 million during October but were 3 million less than a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks at 531 million pounds were up 107 million from October 1 but were 76 million pounds less than a year earlier. Turkey holdings at 430 million pounds were up 100 million from a month earlier but were 75 million less than a year ago. Whole turkeys totaled 397 million pounds on November 1. Parts, cut-ups, and further processed turkey items totaled 32 million pounds.

Shell eggs totaled 42 thousand cases, down 43 thousand during October and 130 thousand below a year earlier. Frozen egg holdings were 53 million pounds, down 4 million from October 1 and 40 million below a year earlier.

Dairy Products

Creamery butter in cold storage totaled 126 million pounds, 29 million less than a month earlier and 36 million less than a year earlier. Government-owned butter on November 1 totaled 94 million pounds, down 28 million from October 1.

American cheese holdings were 293 million pounds, down 16 million from the previous month and 53 million less than a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 33 million gallons, 6 million less than a month earlier but 11 million more than a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 630 million pounds, 17 million more than a month earlier and 41 million above a year earlier.

Stocks of fresh apples were 3,095 million pounds, 1,867 million more than a month earlier and 792 million above a year earlier. Fresh grapes totaled 203 million pounds--up 122 million pounds from a month earlier.

Holdings of frozen vegetables (excluding french fries) totaled 1,630 million pounds, 63 million more than a month earlier but 4 million less than a year earlier.

French fried potato stocks totaled 342 million pounds, 60 million more than on October 1 and 47 million above a year earlier.
