

COLD STORAGE Report

March 1, 1970

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Changes During February

Cold storage stocks decreased during February for fresh apples, American cheese, frozen eggs, turkeys, strawberries, green peas and corn. Stocks increased during the month for butter, shell eggs, orange juice, french fried potatoes, beef and pork.

Stocks of apples declined 453 million pounds during February; American cheese, 11 million; frozen eggs, 1 million; turkeys, 31 million; strawberries, 9 million; green peas, 32 million and corn 34 million pounds.

Stocks of butter increased 4 million pounds during February; shell eggs, 34 thousand cases; orange juice, 11 million gallons; french fried potatoes, 34 million pounds; beef, 19 million pounds and pork, 30 million pounds.

Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Total stocks in cooler space on March 1 totaled 2,704 million pounds, down 522 million during February but 442 million above a year earlier. Freezer-held stocks totaled 4,410 million pounds on March 1, up 2 million from February 1 and 224 million above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on March 1 compared with 60 percent on both February 1 and a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased during the month in the New England and Mountain regions, decreased in the Middle Atlantic, and was unchanged in all other regions.

Freezer space in public warehouses was 65 percent occupied on March 1, compared with 67 percent both a month earlier and a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased during the month in the South Atlantic region and decreased in all other regions.

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(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. February 28, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 387 million pounds on March 1, up 19 million from February 1 and 116 million above a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 241 million pounds were up 30 million from a month earlier but 24 million below a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 49 million pounds, up 12 million from February 1 but 7 million below a year ago. Hams, at 30 million pounds, were 11 million above a month earlier and 2 million above a year earlier.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Turkey stocks totaled 131 million pounds on March 1, down 31 million from February 1 and 124 million below a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 107 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 24 million. Broiler stocks increased slightly during February to 27 million pounds on March 1, up 5 million from a year earlier.

Shell egg stocks totaled 80 thousand cases on March 1, up 34 thousand from February 1, and 9 thousand more than a year earlier. Stocks of frozen eggs declined 1 million pounds during February to 39 million on March 1.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 81 million pounds, up 4 million from February 1 but 34 million below a year earlier. Government-owned butter was 50 million pounds, down 1 million from February 1 and 48 million from a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 238 million pounds, down 11 million from a month earlier and 33 million from a year earlier.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 51 million gallons on March 1, up 11 million from February 1 and 18 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 1,271 million pounds, down 453 million from a month earlier but 420 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 531 million pounds, down 33 million from February 1, but 36 million above a year earlier. The largest declines during February were in cherries and strawberries. Apples were the only frozen fruit showing an increase during February.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 1,143 million pounds, down 126 million from February 1 and 48 million below a year earlier. The largest declines during February were in green peas and cut corn.

French fried potato stocks totaled 493 million pounds, an increase of 34 million during February and 10 million from a year earlier.
