May 1, 1970

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Changes During April

Cold storage stocks decreased during April for fresh and frozen apples, turkeys, corn, green peas and beef. Commodities with increases in stocks during April include butter, American cheese, strawberries, orange juice, french fried potatoes and pork.

Fresh apple stocks declined 363 million pounds and frozen apples 6 million during April, turkeys 18 million pounds, corn 34 million, green peas 27 million and beef 18 million pounds.

Increases during April included butter 26 million pounds, American cheese 22 million, strawberries 5 million, french fried potatoes 26 million, pork 65 million pounds and orange juice 6 million gallons.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on May 1 totaled 1,807 million pounds, down 357 million pounds from April 1, but 143 million above a year earlier. Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,350 million pounds on May 1, up 66 million pounds from a month earlier and 290 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 58 percent occupied on May 1, compared with 59 percent on April 1 and 61 percent a year earlier. Cooler occupancy increased during April in the New England, East North Central and West North Central Regions, but declined in all other regions.

Freezer space was 65 percent occupied on May 1, up slightly from 64 percent on April 1 but the same as a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased during April in the East North Central, West North Central, South Atlantic and West South Central Regions, declined in the Middle Atlantic and Pacific Regions and held unchanged elsewhere.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. April 30, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 361 million pounds on May 1, down 18 million from April 1 but 94 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 334 million pounds were up 65 million from a month earlier and 10 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 74 million pounds, up 13 million from April 1 but 22 million below a year ago. Hams, at 42 million pounds, were 17 million above a month earlier and 8 million above a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 207 million pounds, were 16 million below April 1 and 32 million less than a year earlier. Turkey stocks totaled 83 million pounds on May 1, down 18 million from April 1 and 72 million less than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 63 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 19 million.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 117 million pounds, up 26 million from April 1 but 17 million less than a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 79 million pounds, up 15 million from April 1 but 27 million less than a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 261 million pounds, up 22 million from a month earlier and 1 million above a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 54 million gallons on May 1, up 6 million from April 1 and 13 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 447 million pounds, down 363 million from a month earlier but 132 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 454 million pounds, down 33 million from April 1, but 47 million above a year earlier. The largest decline during April was in cherries. Strawberries were the only frozen fruit showing an increase during the month.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 968 million pounds, down 86 million from April 1 and 48 million less than a year earlier. The largest declines were recorded for corn and green peas. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for spinach.

French fried potato stocks totaled 556 million pounds, an increase of 26 million during April and 33 million above a year earlier.
