Changes During May

Cold storage stocks decreased during May for fresh apples, turkeys, beef, all frozen fruits except strawberries and most frozen vegetables. Commodities with increases in stocks during May include butter, cheese, orange juice, chicken and pork.

Fresh apple stocks declined 255 million pounds during May, turkeys 9 million, beef 14 million, frozen fruits 20 million and frozen vegetables 81 million pounds.

Stock increases during May included butter 34 million pounds, cheese 27 million, chicken 9 million, pork 12 million pounds and orange juice 18 million gallons.

Total Cooler and Freezer Stocks

Stocks of all commodities in cooler space on June 1 totaled 1,522 million pounds, down 279 million from May 1 but 64 million pounds above a year earlier.

Stocks in freezer space totaled 4,481 million pounds on June 1, up 115 million from a month earlier and 479 million pounds above a year earlier.

Public Warehouse Occupancy

Cooler space in public warehouses was 59 percent occupied on June 1, the same as a month earlier, but 2 points below a year earlier. Gains in cooler occupancy during May in the West North Central, South Atlantic and East South Central Regions were offset by declines in the Mid-Atlantic, West South Central and Pacific Regions. Other regions were unchanged.

Freezer space was 67 percent occupied on June 1, up 1 point from May 1 and 4 points above a year earlier. Freezer occupancy increased during May in all Regions except the East North Central where there was a slight decline, and the West South Central which was unchanged.

(Data for this report are collected from public, private, and semi-private warehouses, apple houses, and meat packing plants in the 48 States where food products are generally stored for 30 days or more. Commodities in space owned or leased and operated by the armed service are not reported. May 31, 1970 data are preliminary.)

Meat Products

Beef stocks totaled 354 million pounds on June 1, down 14 million from May 1 but 107 million more than a year earlier. Total pork holdings of 341 million pounds were up 12 million from a month earlier and 43 million above a year earlier. Frozen pork bellies totaled 81 million pounds, up 7 million from May 1 but 15 million below a year ago. Hams, at 46 million pounds, were 5 million above a month earlier and 18 million above a year ago.

Poultry and Poultry Products

Frozen poultry stocks, at 213 million pounds, were up 5 million from a month earlier and 6 million from a year ago. Turkey stocks totaled 73 million pounds on June 1, down 9 million from May 1 and 50 million less than a year earlier. Whole turkeys totaled 54 million pounds, and parts, cut-ups and further processed turkey items totaled 19 million.

Dairy Products

Butter stocks totaled 149 million pounds, up 34 million from May 1, but 14 million less than a year earlier. Government-owned butter totaled 105 million pounds, up 29 million from May 1 but 27 million less than a year earlier.

American cheese holdings totaled 281 million pounds, up 23 million from a month earlier, but the same as a year ago.

Fruits, Juices and Vegetables

Stocks of orange concentrate (45° brix equivalent) totaled 71 million gallons on June 1, up 18 million from May 1 and 21 million above a year earlier.

Fresh apple holdings totaled 192 million pounds, down 255 million from a month earlier, but 55 million above a year earlier.

Frozen fruits totaled 446 million pounds, down 20 million from May 1, but 75 million above a year earlier. The largest decline during May was in apples. Strawberries were the only frozen fruit showing an increase during the month.

Frozen vegetable stocks (excluding french fries) totaled 908 million pounds, down 75 million from May 1 and 38 million less than a year earlier. The largest decline was in corn. The largest increase in stocks was recorded for broccoli.

French fried potato stocks totaled 562 million pounds, a decline of 6 million during May, but 61 million above a year earlier.
